

Instruction to candidates for **JENPARH-2015**, the Joint Entrance Examination for admission to i) **B.H.M.S.** (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery), ii) **B.A.M.S.** (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery), iii) **B.U.M.S.** (Bachelor of Unani Medicine & Surgery), iv) **B.Sc. Nursing** (Bachelor of Nursing), v) **B.P.T.** (Bachelor of Physiotherapy) courses in Colleges/ Institutes in the State of West Bengal for the academic session 2015 - 2016.

West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board (WBJEEB) will conduct **JENPARH-2015** and the examination schedule will be as follows:

EXAMINATION AND QUESTION PATTERN:

A written test consisting of the following papers will be conducted by **WBJEEB**:

Paper I: Biological Sciences (100 marks)
Paper II: Physics & Chemistry (100 marks).

Each paper will contain hundred (100) one (1) mark questions based on **Higher Secondary syllabus of WBCHSE**. All questions will be of **Multiple Choice Question (MCQ)** type. Answers are to be marked (bubbled) on **OMR Answer Sheets** using black/blue ball point pen.

Each question will have **four answer options** of which **only one is correct**. Each **correct response** will fetch **1 mark**, each **incorrect response** will fetch **(-1/4) mark**, whereas **no response** will fetch **zero mark**. **Multiple responses** for any question will fetch **(-1/4) marks**.

The questions will be printed in **English** following by its **Bangla version**.

RANKING METHODOLOGY & RULES FOR TIE-BREAKING :

In **JENPARH-2015** the merit list for successful candidates will be prepared by listing them in the descending order of the total marks scored by them. However, there may be ties and such ties will be broken by sequentially applying the following set of rules:

1. Less negative marks in Biology, Physics & Chemistry taken together
2. More positive marks in Biology and Chemistry taken together
3. More positive marks in Biology and Physics taken together
4. Less negative marks in Biology and Chemistry taken together
5. Less negative marks in Biology and Physics taken together

In generation of the merit list, if after applying the 5 rules stated above there are still ties, same will be broken by the date of birth (DOB) of the concerned candidates; the older candidate will be given preference over the younger one.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicant must be a Citizen of India and domicile of West Bengal.
Age: Not less than 17 years as on 31st December, 2015 for all courses.

(a) **B.H.M.S. and B.P.T.:** Candidates having passed/appeared/due to appear in the year 2015 in the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) or equivalent examination recognized by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education with the subjects English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Vernacular (or any other 5th subject) are eligible. Candidates must have individual pass marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

(b) **B.A.M.S.:** Candidates having passed/appeared/due to appear in the year 2015 in the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) or equivalent examination recognized by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education with the subjects English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Vernacular (or any other 5th subject) are eligible. Candidates must have 50% (Fifty percent) aggregate marks in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

(c) **B.U.M.S:** Candidates having passed/appeared/due to appear in the year 2015 in the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) or equivalent examination recognized by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education with the subjects English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Vernacular (or any other 5th subject) are eligible. Candidates must have 50% (Fifty percent) aggregate marks in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Candidates should have passed 10th standard with Urdu or Arabic or Persian as a subject, or clear the test of Urdu in the entrance examination conducted by the University or Board or recognized society authorized by the Government to conduct such examination.

(d) **B.Sc. Nursing:** Only female **candidates** having passed/appeared/due to appear in the year 2015 at the Higher Secondary Examination from West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) or equivalent Board Examination like AISSCE / CBSE / ICSE / SSCE / HSCE or other equivalent Board examination with 50% marks (40% for SC/ST) in the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English taken together and with pass marks in each subject individually are eligible.

RESIDENTIAL CRITERIA:

For admission to Govt. Colleges candidates must have been residing in the State of West Bengal for a minimum period of 10 (ten) years uninterruptedly as on 31.12.2014 or their parents must be permanent resident of West Bengal having their permanent home address in the State of West Bengal. However, candidates of states other than West Bengal may be considered for admission to non-Govt. Colleges/Institutions.

Residential certificate in this regard shall have to be produced during counselling in the proforma given in Annexure of the Information Brochure from any of the competent Authorities as mentioned below. Separate supporting documents or residential certificate in any other form will not be accepted.

For candidates seeking admission to Govt. Colleges, submission of Residential Certificate in prescribed format from competent authority is **mandatory**.

COMPETENT AUTHORITIES FOR ISSUANCE OF RESIDENTIAL CERTIFICATE:

The Residential Certificate as applicable should be obtained from any of the following competent authorities in whose jurisdiction the candidate resides.

- i) District Magistrate; ii) Additional District Magistrate; iii) Deputy Magistrate & Deputy Collector; v) Sub – Divisional Officer; vi) Block Development Officer
- vii) Superintendent of Police, viii) Additional Supdt. of Police; ix) Sub Divisional Police Officer or Deputy Supdt. of Police, x) Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner of Police Commissionerate
- xi) Judicial Magistrate of any rank or position in the concerned district or Metropolitan locality or Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or Hon'ble Supreme Court of India
- xii) Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner of Municipal Corporation; xiii) Executive Officer of Municipality;
- xiv) Assistant Secretary / equivalent or above in the Secretariat to the Government of West Bengal (including GTA) or Central Government; xv) Deputy Director or above in the Directorate to the Government of West Bengal or Central Government.
- xvi) Heads of the Institutions (located in West Bengal) where the applicants are presently studying or last studied

Every official certifying the Residential Status of the candidate or his/her parents MUST provide one's FULL NAME, DESIGNATION, PLACE OF POSTING WITH ADDRESS AND OFFICE LANDLINE NUMBER. These details are MANDATORY. *CERTIFICATION FROM ANY AUTHORITY OTHER THAN WHAT HAVE BEEN ENUMERATED ABOVE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.*

Note: No elected people's representative like municipal commissioner, councillor of Municipal Corporation, any elected member of three-tier Panchayat system or GTA, MLA or MP is entitled to issue such certificates.

RESERVATION:

Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B category candidates will be done as per Govt. Rules.

APPLICATION:

Candidates intending to appear in **JENPARH-2015** shall have to apply through **ONLINE** (www.wbjeeb.in) from **21.04.2015 to 10.05.2015**. The candidates can also be download the **e-challan** from the same link, the official website of the Board, from **21-04-2015 to 11-05-2015**.

The duly filled-in e-challan needs to be submitted with **Rs. 506/- in cash** (Application fee: Rs. 500/-, Bank charges: Rs. 6/-) in any one of the branches of Allahabad Bank as notified in the website on all working days. The applicant may download the **Information Brochure** from the website.

SUBMISSION:

The Application Form should be submitted **ONLINE** only. There is **no need to send** any hard copy of the Acknowledgement receipt or any document to the board office. Details are given in Annexure.

ISSUE OF ADMIT CARD WITH EXAMINATION ROLL NUMBER:

Admit Card for each eligible applicant showing his/her Application Number, Examination Roll Number, Examination Centre along with relevant personal information will be available at www.wbjeeb.in from **22.05.2015** till the day of examination. Applicant should download the Admit Card and carry it along with him/her to the Examination Centre.

Candidates must ensure that the photographs on the admit card are not mutilated / distorted/soiled even by accident. Candidates with such Admit Cards will not be allowed to appear in the Entrance Examination.

Candidates must retain their admit cards carefully in a secured place in undamaged condition till the completion of admission procedure.

No duplicate Admit Card will be issued after the Entrance Examination from the Board Office. However, during counselling, candidates will once again be allowed to download their Admit Cards.

ZONE OF EXAMINATION:

The Examination will be held simultaneously at the following zones, provided there are sufficient candidates in the Zone. If sufficient applicants are not available for a particular zone, nearby zone will be allotted to them.

The allotment of zone and examination centre is fully at the discretion of the Board. Any allotment made by the Board is final and no request for changing the zone / centre of examination will be entertained under any circumstances.

EVALUATION AND DECLARATION OF RESULTS OF JENPARH-2015 :

Rules for scrutiny/review of Answer Sheet: The Board neither publishes nor communicates the result to any individual applicant. It does not have any provision for post publication, scrutiny and/or review and hence will not entertain any such application after the examination.

Result: Result of JENPARH-2015 is likely to be declared by the last week of June, 2015. The Board will publish the merit list(s) at its website, viz. www.wbjeeb.in. The total number of candidates to be merit listed will be decided by appropriate authority.

Merit listed candidates will be allowed to download their **Rank Cards** from www.wbjeeb.in.

LEGAL JURISDICTION :

All disputes pertaining to the conduction of JENPARH-2015 shall fall within the jurisdiction of Kolkata only. The Board will not be a party pertaining to any dispute arising in the process of admission to any course of study through JENPARH-2015.

COUNSELLING & ADMISSION :

Counselling and admission to **B.A.M.S., B.H.M.S., B.U.M.S., B.P.T.** and **B.Sc. Nursing** courses will be held after getting permission from respective apex councils of the country. Securing a rank in the merit list in the said examination does not

constitute a right/guarantee in favour of the candidate for his/her admission/counselling.

All applicants who appear to be prima-facie eligible are provisionally permitted to sit for the Entrance Examination. If after scrutiny at any stage, it is found that an applicant is otherwise ineligible, his/her candidature will automatically be cancelled even if he/she has appeared at the examination and secured a position in the merit list.

It should be noted that **WBJEEB** does not conduct the counselling and subsequent admission to the aforesaid courses. The Board only conducts the Entrance Examination, evaluates the answer scripts and generates the merit list of the said examination. The counselling is conducted by:

(i) **Central Selection Committee (AYUSH)**, Swasthya Bhawan, G.N. 29, Sector - V, Salt Lake, Kolkata – 700091, under the aegis of **Dept. of Health & Family Welfare**, Govt. of West Bengal conducts the counselling for admission to **B.A.M.S., B.H.M.S., B.U.M.S., B.P.T.** (Degree) courses.

(ii) **Central Selection Committee (Nursing)**, W.B. Govt. College of Nursing, Kolkata, SSKM Hospital Campus, 244, A.J.C. Bose Road, Kolkata-700020 conducts the counselling for admission to **B.Sc. Nursing** course.

At the time of admission a candidate shall be required to produce the original mark sheets of all the examinations passed, a document certifying his/her date of birth. (Admit Card of Madhyamik or equivalent examination), the Admit card of JENPARH-2015, Rank card of JENPARH-2015, Residential Certificate and other relevant documents (e.g. Caste certificate for reserved category candidate; PwD certificate for PwD category candidates) for the purpose of verification.

Successful candidates are advised to seek detailed information regarding counselling and admission to aforesaid course from the respective Central Selection Committee.

MEDICAL FITNESS :

The candidates finally selected for admission to the respective courses will be required to undergo medical check-up within the dates specified by the respective Colleges.

Only those candidates declared medically fit would be considered for admission.

CERTIFICATE FOR RESERVED CATEGORY CANDIDATES:

Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe candidates in W.B., as specified in Govt. of W.B. Order No. 1813-PCW/1VIR-94/11 dated 20.06.2011 are eligible for admission through Joint Entrance Examination. **However, SC/ST candidates hailing from States other than West Bengal are not eligible for such benefit and they shall be treated as General category candidates.** The Caste certificates will have to be produced at the time of counselling from the following competent authorities.

A-(i) Deputy Director, Backward classes welfare, W.B. (ii) Commissioner, Backward classes welfare, W.B. in case candidates claiming to be SC or ST residing in any part of West Bengal.

B-(i) Deputy Collector of Land Revenue, Kolkata (ii) Collector of Stamp Revenue, Kolkata (iii) Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata (iv) Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata (v) Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata (vi) 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate (vii) Executive Magistrate (viii) Sub-divisional Magistrate (ix) Sub-divisional Officer (x) Deputy Collector (xi) Additional District Magistrate (xii) Collector and (xiii) District Magistrate within their respective jurisdictions - in case of candidate claiming to be SC or ST and ordinarily residing within such jurisdictions.

For OBC candidates, the competent authority for issuing certificates will be put up on the website (www.wbjeeb.in) as soon as the relevant Government Order is issued.

CERTIFICATE FOR PwD CANDIDATES:

The seats earmarked for **PwD** candidates shall be filled up by candidates with **locomotor disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70%**. However, in case any seat in the earmarked quota remains unfilled on account of non availability of candidates with locomotor disability between 50% to 70%, such unfilled seats in the said quota shall be filled up by persons with **locomotor disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50%**.

Candidates claiming seats under PwD category are required to produce PwD certificate from competent authority.

Guidelines for filling up the online form

Application has to be filled up **ONLINE** at the portal of the Board, <http://www.wbjeeb.in>.

Candidates need to visit the portal and CLICK the requisite link ONLINE APPLICATION FOR **JENPARH/EVETS/BOTH – 2015** and thereafter will be directed to the actual application form. The form is interactive in nature and the fields required to be filled up are categorized in different sub-sections. The fields super-scribed with * **MUST be filled up as they are MANDATORY**, otherwise the application will NOT get submitted.

The application form is broadly categorized into three steps: filling of **PERSONAL DETAILS; IMAGE UPLOADING & FEE PAYMENT**.

Candidates need to fill in the first part i.e. PERSONAL DETAILS and will thereafter be directed to IMAGE UPLOADING. Once the documents are successfully uploaded, the system enters into the FEE PAYMENT. Finally, the candidate may take a printout of **CONFIRMATION PAGE** generated upon successful fee payment for their own record. **There is no need to send any document by post.**

Please note that the applicant name, father's name, mother's name and date of birth taken together must be unique for each application.

On completion and submission of the PERSONAL DETAILS, the system will generate a unique 7-digit numeric **APPLICATION NUMBER** for the candidate. Once an Application Number is generated, the candidate may logout of the system. The candidate will need to enter the system subsequently using this system generated Application Number and own date of birth (as entered during form fill-up) for subsequent login to the system for all subsequent accesses to the system for various reasons as given below:

- Viewing and editing personal information (till going to the image upload stage)
- Uploading of photo and signature as images
- Printing of e-Challan for Bank
- Printing of the Confirmation Page
- Result details after examination

The application number may be retrieved by submitting the applicant name, father's name, mother's name and date of birth.

IMAGE UPLOADING:

All candidates are required to upload the following three images and document:

1. **Recent coloured Passport sized Photograph**
2. **Own Signature**

FEE PAYMENT:

The candidate has to select "Allahabad Bank e-challan" to submit the application fee through bank. As soon as he selects it an **e-Challan** will be generated containing details of the candidate. The candidate has to take a printout of the same and take it to the nearest **Core Banking Service (CBS) facility enabled Branch of the Bank** for making **payment**. After payment, the candidate has to login to the system and upload the details written on the e-Challan (**Journal No., Branch Name and Date** etc.) by the bank official.

CONFIRMATION PAGE:

When the details are uploaded, the **Confirmation Page** will be generated. Its generation implies the candidate has successfully **REGISTERED**. The candidate should preserve the confirmation page printout for future reference. **There is no need to send any document to the Board by post or other means.**
