## GENERAL INFORMATION

- i. Admission to these courses will be strictly on the basis of rank/merit obtained in GMCH Combined Entrance Test (GCET-2016) to be conducted by Government Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh.
- ii. The courses are open to Indian Nationals.
- iii. Age: Minimum 17 years as on 31.12.2016
- iv. The candidate should clearly specify the category against which he/she wishes to apply (General/SC/In-service).
- v. Candidates desirous of applying for more than one course are not required to submit separate application form. The candidates shall be admitted, as per their preference of discipline if available at the time of counseling, in order of their rank in the GCET-2016.
- vi. A candidate must have secured following minimum percentage of marks in the aggregate in 12<sup>th</sup> standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination:  
General category: not less than 45%  
SC category: not less than 40%
- vii. A candidate appearing/appeared in the qualifying 12th Standard examination or other equivalent qualifying examination in 2016 where result is awaited can also apply. However he/she shall not be eligible for admission, if he/she does not pass the qualifying examination with the required pass percentage of marks prior to the first round of Counseling. He/she will be allowed to attend first counseling only if detailed marks certificate of the above said examination is submitted prior to or at the time of first counseling, failing which he/she will be declared ineligible for admission year 2016 and his/her application will be rejected.
- viii. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of rank secured in GCET-2016.
- ix. A candidate must have come in the merit list of GCET- 2016 by securing following minimum marks:  
General Category: not less than 45%  
SC Category: not less than 40%
- x. The candidates shall be admitted, as per their preference of discipline if available, in order of their rank in the GCET-2016.

- xi. A person in regular employment shall also be eligible as in-service candidate provided he/she possesses requisite essential qualifications and must have come in the merit list of GCET-2016 by securing minimum qualifying marks i.e. 45% for General category and 40% for Scheduled castes (SC) category. He/She should be in regular employment with UT Health Department/Department of Medical Education and Research and has completed experience of five or more years in the concerned discipline in the UT Health Department/Department of Medical Education and Research subject to submission of NOC from the employer.
- xii. Seats remaining vacant in any of the reserved categories in all the courses shall be filled from the eligible General Category candidates from respective pool in accordance with the prevailing rules on this subject.
- xiii. Seat(s) remaining unfilled from General Pool shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool General Category candidates.
- xiv. If after second counseling for UT Chandigarh Pool candidates, seats remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible UT Chandigarh Pool candidates the same will be filled from General Pool candidate(s).



## DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS

- i. **UT Chandigarh Pool (85%)\*\*:-** Chandigarh Administration's circular No. 19/1/93/IH (3-99/11136) dated 9th June, 1999 provides that 85% seats of the total sanctioned intake of an institution will be filled up from amongst the students who pass their qualifying examination from schools/colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and located in the Union Territory, Chandigarh, as regular students of the said school/college.
- ii. **General Pool (15%):-** Remaining 15% seats will be filled from amongst students, who passed their qualifying examination from institutions other than those located in the Union Territory, Chandigarh.
- iii. **In both pools, 15%\* seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes (SC).**

\*In calculation of percentage of seats for reserved category/categories the figure has been rounded off to lower whole number if decimal point is less than 0.5, and to higher whole number if the decimal point is 0.5 or more.

\*\*All seats in PRE HOSPITAL TRAUMA TECHNICIAN COURSE (PHTTC, 9 MONTHS CERTIFICATE COURSE) are open to UT Chandigarh Pool and General Pool.

- c) A person who has passed Part-I of B.Sc. medical with aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates from any institution recognized by Panjab University.
- d) A person holding qualification of 3 yrs. Diploma in MLT (equivalent to 10+2) & must have obtained aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates, from any recognized Board/Council/University, shall also be eligible.

- c) A person who has passed Part –I of B.Sc Medical with aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates from any institution recognized by Panjab University.
- d) A person holding qualification of diploma in Radiography/X-ray Techniques must have obtained aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates from any recognized Board/Council/University shall also be eligible provided he/she joined diploma course after passing 10+2 examination with Science (physics, chemistry and biology) subjects.

- b) A person who has passed 10+2 Vocational Course (Ophthalmic Technique) in their respective elective subjects and English with aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates conducted by recognized Board/Council / University.
- c) A person who has passed Part –I of B.Sc medical with aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates from any institution recognized by Panjab University.

- b) Students appearing in 10+2 examination in Science conducted by National Institute of Open School will also be eligible provided they secure aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for SC candidates.

**Note:**

All admissions to B.Sc Nursing course shall be provisional and subject to the approval of Panjab University, Punjab Nurses Registration Council and Indian Nursing Council.

Candidates who possess one of the following qualifications shall be eligible to apply for admission in the Pre-Hospital Trauma Technician (PHTTC) course:

- a)** A person who has passed 10+2 examination in Science group with aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English as subjects conducted by a recognized Board/Council/University.
- b)** The admissible age limit for the said course as on 31.12.2016 should be between 17 years to 25 years.

## SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

### Scheme of examination shall be as under:

- i. The medium of GCET-2016 will be English only.
- ii. Paper will consist of 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)
- iii. Each question will carry 1 (one) mark (maximum marks 100)
- iv. There will be no negative marking.
- v. For all the courses, the duration of the entrance test will be of two hours.
- vi. The minimum qualifying marks in GCET-2016 for inclusion in the list of successful candidates are as below:

General category: not less than 45%

SC category: not less than 40%

## PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR EXAMINATION CUM ADMISSION

- i. Candidate has to fill online application form available at GMCH website: **www.gmch.gov.in**
- ii. Before applying, candidates are advised to go through the admission notice and the instructions carefully, published in the newspapers / prospectus and then fill in the online application form.
- iii. Before applying for any course, the candidates should ensure that he/she fulfils all the eligibility norms. The candidate should have the requisite educational qualifications from recognized University/Institute. GMCH, Chandigarh can reject the applications of candidates at any stage of admission process in case the candidate is not fulfilling the requisite criteria.
- iv. Candidate has to fill only one online application form. No additional form is to be filled after declaration of result.
- v. **Payment of application fee:**
  - a) Candidate should fill his/her Application form available on the GMCH website. He/she should fill up all the relevant fields in the form. No field/Column should be left blank. After filling up application form, the candidate should take a printout of the Challan form (triplicate) and deposit the application fee on next working day in any Branch of State Bank of India.
  - b) Candidates should go to any Branch of State Bank of India with the fee Payment Challan duly filled in and pay the prescribed Application Fee in the “**Power Jyoti**” account of GMCH. The candidates, after having deposited the application fee in the bank, must ensure that they have Triplicate Fee Payment Challan with Journal No./Challan No. given by the bank on it. They should mention this Journal/Challan number in the application form and keep this Challan form with them for future use.
  - c) The amount of fee to be paid is as under:-  
Rs. 500/- (General Category) + Bank charges (if any)  
Rs. 300/- (SC Category) + Bank charges (if any)
  - d) Candidates should ensure that the details to be filled in by the State Bank of India officials are filled in all three (03) copies of the challan along with the seal, Challan no. and signature of the Bank Official of the Branch.

- e) Candidates must note that no other mode of payment of application fee like Demand Draft, Cheque, Money Order, etc. will be accepted under any circumstances. GMCH, Chandigarh will not be responsible for any remittance made in any form other than the method prescribed above and such applications without requisite application fee submitted through any other mode except prescribed above are likely to be rejected.
- vi. **All 10+2 (Medical Group i.e. Physics, Chemistry & Biology) passed candidate will be eligible for all courses. They are not required to fill course option.** Candidate can choose discipline/course at the time of counseling on the basis of merit obtained in the Entrance examination subject to the availability of the seats in the respective course.
- vii. Candidates who possess vocational course qualification/in-service candidates will be considered for admission only in the course related to the subject of their vocational course/experience. They should select the relevant course from the options available in the online application form.
- viii. No addition of category of reservation will be allowed once form has been submitted online.
- ix. All students who have applied online will be allowed to sit in the entrance examination.

- ii. **Inter-se-merit:** If two or more candidates obtain equal marks in the Entrance Test, then the inter-se-merit for admission to the course shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in +2 or equivalent examination. If the marks are equal then the merit will be determined on the basis of age i.e. preference will be given to the candidate who is older in age.
- iii. Candidates have to appear in person for **counseling on the date as intimated on the website later on**. The counseling will be held in the office of the Director Principal, GMCH-32, Chandigarh. Personal appearance of the candidate before the Counseling/Admission Committee is mandatory for claiming seat as per rank/merit determined and displayed.
- iv. The candidates should report at the counseling venue with any one of the following photo identification proofs:
  - a) Passport
  - b) Driving license
  - c) Voter identify card
  - d) Any other document, such as PAN card, Aadhaar card etc., issued by Government agency
- v. The candidates should bring with them the following original documents alongwith two passport size photographs at the time of counseling:
  - a) Admit Card
  - b) Date of Birth certificate/ 10<sup>th</sup> passing certificate
  - c) Passing certificate of 10+2 examination

**Important Note:**

- a) No separate counseling letter will be issued
  - b) No TA/DA will be paid for attending counseling
  - c) Attested copies of the certificates or similar other documents will not be entertained for granting admission to a candidate.
  - d) Mere attending counseling for a course doesn't confer any right to admission in that course. Admission will be strictly according to the rank/merit in Entrance Test (GCET)-2016
- vii. Sequence of counseling will be for General Category seats first, followed by Reserved Category seats.
- viii. All qualified UT Chandigarh Pool /General Pool reserved category candidates will be considered for admission against General category seats in their respective pool according to their rank / merit in the combined list, in addition to the category they have applied for.
- ix. Candidates belonging to reserved category, who obtain admission in the General category on the basis of their rank/merit in the Entrance Test (GCET-2016), shall not be counted towards the seats for the reserved category concerned.
- x. If a qualified candidate reports late for counseling when his/her turn according to his / her rank / merit has already been passed over, he/she will be considered as per available seats at the time of his/her actual reporting in the counseling.

- xi. Second counseling will be conducted for the vacant seats, if any. Information to this effect will be displayed on notice board and Website of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.
- xii. An otherwise qualified candidate who did not appear in the first counseling is allowed to appear in the second counseling and will be offered the available seat as per his/her rank/merit in the second counseling.
- xiii. Candidate once admitted cannot participate in counseling again except in case where he/she wants to change his/her discipline/course of admission. He/ she has to surrender the seat in writing before the start of 2<sup>nd</sup> counseling i.e. one day prior to the day of 2<sup>nd</sup> counseling
- xiv. **In case of non-availability of qualified SC candidates in UT Pool / General Pool, these seats will be filled from qualified General Category candidates from respective pool.**
- xv. Seat(s) remaining unfilled from General Pool shall be filled from eligible UT Chandigarh Pool General Category candidates.
- xvi. At second counseling a waiting list, according to the rank/merit of candidates who appeared in this counseling, will be prepared for filling up the seats which may fall vacant before the closing date for admission. Information to this effect will be displayed on notice board and Website of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.
- xvii. If after second counseling for UT Chandigarh Pool candidates, seats remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible UT Chandigarh Pool candidates the same will be filled from General Pool candidate(s).

## **ADMISSION**

- i. The selected candidates will have to undergo medical examination by the constituted Medical Board on the same day or succeeding day of counseling. Candidates found medically fit shall be granted admission.
- ii. The candidates who do not appear before the Medical Board or are found medically unfit shall not be allowed to join the course.
- iii. Fees are to be paid on the day of medical examination after candidate is found medically fit. The candidature of the eligible candidates, who do not deposit the prescribed fees in full, shall stand automatically cancelled and vacancies so caused shall be offered to the candidates next in order of merit. No correspondence or appeal in this connection will be entertained by the Admission Committee.
- iv. Admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with the rules / criteria mentioned in this brochure. However, in all matters which need interpretation or for which no provision exists in the brochure, the decision of the Admission Committee shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained regarding rejection or disqualification of any candidate.
- v. The original certificates of the selected candidates will be retained by the college. The original certificates of the selected candidates shall be returned only if the seat is surrendered in writing by the candidate.
- vi. In case the information furnished or certificates/documents submitted by the candidate are found to be fake or is found to have withheld or concealed information in the application form, his/her admission shall stand cancelled and the fee deposited shall be forfeited. In addition he/she may also face legal action under the law of the land.
- vii. **All admissions shall be provisional and subject to the approval of concerned regulatory bodies.**
- viii. All legal disputes relating to admission of students will be subject to courts have jurisdiction in Chandigarh.

### **Important Note:**

## FEE CONCESSIONS, ETC.

- i. Selected candidates will have to pay fee and other dues as below:

- ii. The annual fee can be deposited, in cash, or through demand draft in favour of **Director Principal, Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.**  
Payable at Chandigarh
- iii. Half Freeship on tuition fee shall be admissible to all students belonging to S.C. category throughout the course, subject to successful results at all University examinations.
- iv. Full freeship on tuition fee/Hostel fee shall be admissible to 5% students in each class belonging to economically weaker sections whose parents/guardians income from all sources does not exceed ₹ 2,50,000/- per annum. Students concerned shall be required to file an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper of ₹ 3/-, duly attested by a Magistrate, stating the above fact. If at any stage the affidavit is found to be false, the student shall be liable to be expelled from the college and further action will be taken as per provisions of the law.
- v. At present the sanctioned strength of B.Sc Courses students is 99 (B.Sc MLT-12; B.Sc X-Ray-12; B.Sc Anaesthesia & OT-16; B.Optom-04; B.Sc Nursing-35; PHTTC-20). Full freeship on tuition fee would be provided to 05 (five students i.e. 5%) students admitted at the time of admission of the first academic year and subsequently after the declaration of annual examination results. The individual students will be entitled to avail of this freeship from year to year basis if they remain within the top 5% of their class i.e. first five students of the merit list of the prospective examination. The sequence of merit will be determined strictly in accordance with the merit secured in the qualifying examination. However, if two or more candidates have similar marks in the examination, the order of merit in the preceding examination shall be taken into consideration for determining the sequence of merit.

- vi. Half freeship on tuition fee would be admissible to the next 05 (five) students i.e. the next 5% of students upon the same merit criteria as mentioned in para (V) above so as to maintain the number of 05 (Five) students for this Freeship on tuition fee i.e. equal to 10% (5% for full Freeship & 5% to half Freeship).
- vii. The freeship as available at paras (1), (2), (3) and (4) above shall be available after the first year subject to the following conditions:
  - a) The student concerned clears all the examinations of the previous year at the first available opportunity; and
  - b) He/she has not been punished for any type of misconduct during the previous qualifying year.
- viii. A meritorious student, who has been granted freeship, can also avail facility of any other scholarship for which he/she is otherwise eligible.
- ix. In case of surrender of seat, the fees and other funds deposited at the time of admission will be refunded after deduction of ₹ 1000/- of total amount paid at the time of admission if seat so vacated gets filled up. If the seat so vacated is not filled up, the entire fee & funds deposited at the time of admission shall stand forfeited and only the security fee will be refunded after the written request by the student.

## OTHER INFORMATION

- i. **Medium of teaching / instructions will be English**
- ii. **Hostel:** No hostel facility will be provided to any student and they have to make their own arrangements for Boarding / lodging.
- iii. **Stipend:** No stipend will be given to any student during the course of any stream.
- iv. **Library:** there is a well-stocked library with all essential professional books, journals and magazine etc.
- v. **Students' Health:** The services of Government Medical College & Hospital will be available to the students during the time of illness
- vi. **Counseling and Guidance:** Students' personal problems will be looked into and necessary counseling and guidance will be given by the teachers. The students are free to approach faculty members for the purpose.
- vii. **Sports and Recreation:** Facilities are available on as well as off the campus.
- viii. **Prevention of Ragging:** Ragging is a cognizable offence. Stern action against the offenders shall be taken. Anyone involved in ragging will be punished in accordance with the law.
