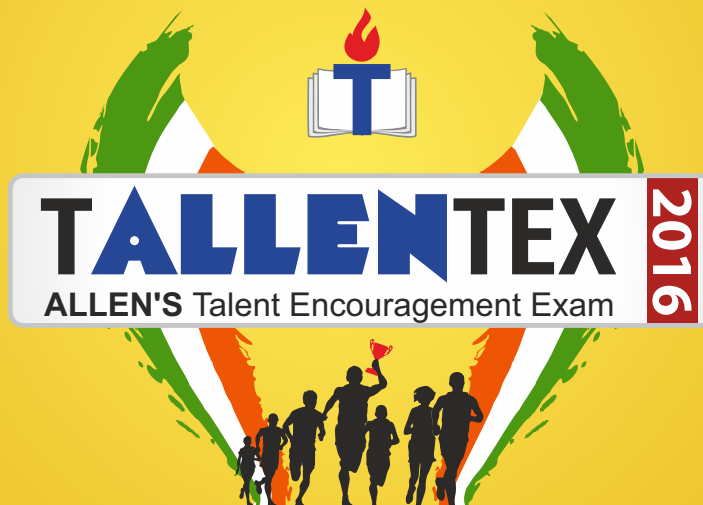

Conditions for Prize :

- (I) **Tie Breaker Rule:** If many students secure equal aggregate marks then higher rank will be given by **comparing subject scores in priority** of Maths/Biology, Physics, Chemistry **For class XI** and Maths, Physics, Chemistry & Biology **Upto class X**. If all subject scores are also equal then IQ score will be compared.
- (II) Admission in ALLEN Course is **NOT mandatory** for TALLENTEX prizes.
- (III) National Top-20 Rank Holders of each class will be given check prize **ONLY IF they attend** SPS function of TALLENTEX 2016

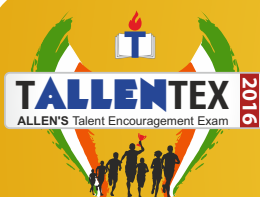
