Applications are invited from the eligible candidates to appear for Karnataka State Eligibility Test (KSET) for Lecturer / Assistant Professorship – 2016 to be conducted on 11th December, 2016.

Important dates:

1. Notification date : 23rd September 2016

2. Submission of online application commences from : 26th September 2016

3. Last date for submission of online application : 25th October 2016

4. Last date for submission of online application with late fee of Rs.150/5. Last date for submission of hard copy of the application:
4th November 2016
10th November 2016

5. Last date for submission of hard copy of the application: form along with copy of receipt/e-challan, category

certificates, to the respective nodal center.

6. Date of Examination : 11th December 2016

Applications should be submitted online and candidates are requested to go through this notification carefully before filling their application.

- KSET center will be conducting this year 2016 test in **39** subjects at eleven (11) nodal centers spread across the Karnataka state.
- Candidates who qualify the KSET 2016 are governed by the recruitment rules and regulations stipulated for Lecturers / Assistant Professors of concerned Universities / Colleges / Institutions (Government/ Aided /Private) of Karnataka State.
- Candidates belongs to Schedule Caste (SC), Schedule Tribe (ST), Persons With Disability (PWD –VH & PH), Category I, IIA, IIB, IIIA and IIIB should be as per the backward classes listed in Government of Karnataka web site: bcdbng@kar.nic.in

Conditions of Eligibility:

- 1. Candidates who have secured at least 55% of marks (without rounding off) for general category and 50% for Schedule Category (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), Persons With Disability (PWD-VH/PH), Category I, IIA, IIB, IIIA and IIIB, in master's degree OR equivalent examination from universities / institutions recognized by UGC New Delhi, in the subjects opted for KSET examination.
- 2. Candidates who have appeared OR will be appearing at the qualifying Master's degree (final year) examination and whose result is still awaited OR candidates whose qualifying examinations have been delayed may also appear for this Test. However, such candidates will be admitted provisionally and for those who clear the KSET examination, eligibility certificate will be issued only on production of proof for having passed the Master's degree or equivalent examination securing at least 55% marks (50% in case of SC, ST, PWD (VH/PH), Category I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB candidates) within two years from the date of KSET examination, failing which they will be treated as disqualified.
- 3. The Ph.D. Degree holders whose Master's degree completed on or before 19th September 1991 (irrespective of declaration of result) shall be eligible for a relaxation of 5% marks for appearing in KSET examination.
- 4. Candidates shall appear for KSET examination in their relevant subject of their post-graduation only, in case the candidate did not find the subject of his post graduation in the list of KSET subjects, the candidate may appear in CBSE UGC-NET / UGC-CSIR NET which is held twice a year.
- 5. Candidates other than general category are required to mention their social status (Category I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB, SC, ST, PWD (VH/PH)) in the online application form. Candidates may note that they should satisfy the eligibility conditions and they are required to submit attested copies of documents such as post graduate degree marks cards, Xth Marks card, category certificates and certificates related to PWD (VH/PH) enclosed with their application. The candidates should submit the category certificates on or before the last date for submission of hard copy of the application form and the certificate should be issued by the competent authority and the issue date of such certificate should be not earlier to 1st July 2015. In case their ineligibility is detected due to invalid certificate by the KSET agency at any stage, their candidature will be cancelled and they shall be liable for legal action.
- 6. Candidates should note that their candidature is provisional. The mere fact that admission to the examination will not imply that the KSET center has finally accepted his/her candidature. Candidates may note that candidature will be deemed final only upon fulfilling of eligibility conditions.
- 7. Candidate who <u>became eligible in earlier KSET TEST</u> are not eligible to apply again <u>in the same subject</u>. If any candidate found to be eligible in previous KSET tests and reappearing for the current KSET their candidature will be cancelled and the previous eligibility is withdrawn through de-notification.

Age limit:

1. There is no upper age limit to apply for KSET examination.

Exemption:

- 1. KSET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment of Lecturers / Assistant Professors in Universities / Colleges / Institutions of Higher education (Government/Aided/Private) in Karnataka State.
 - a. However, as per UGC guidelines, candidates, who have awarded Ph.D. Degree in compliance with the UGC Regulation 2009 (i.e. minimum standards and procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree), shall be exempted from KSET ELIGIBILITY as the minimum requirement for recruitment of Lecturers / Assistant Professors in Universities/ Colleges/ Institutions of Higher education.
 - b. The candidates who have passed the UGC-NET/CSIR JRF examination prior to 1989 are also exempted from KSET examination.

Fee structure and mode of Payment:

Late fee of Rs.150/- has to be paid by candidates who submit online application after the last date till the extended period.

Note: Candidates belonging to category CAT-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB, SC, ST, PWD (VH/PH) who claim fee exemption must enclose attested copy of Category certificate issued by competent authority along with the hard copy of the application.

Mode of payment:

The examination fee / late fee have to be paid by opting either cash payment or online payment. After registration for online application candidates who choose for cash payment can take the printout of PAY IN SLIP and make payment in any of the CANARA BANK CASH COUTERS only and those who opt for online payment they can choose DEBIT CARD, CREDIT CARD, NETBANKING OR NEFT and make payment. After successful payment candidates can take the e-challan provided by the CANARA BANK or a receipt generated from web for online payment. After successful payment candidates can download hard copy of application, attendance slip and admission card.

Please note:

- 1. Fee submitted by any other mode like money order /Demand draft/IPO etc., will NOT be accepted.
- 2. Fee once paid will NOT be refunded under any circumstances.

Scheme and date of examination:

The test will be consisting of three papers. The test for all the three papers will consist of only Multiple-choice Questions (MCQ). The test will be held on 11th December, 2016 in two separate sessions as mentioned below:

Paper-I: General Paper is on Teaching and Aptitude:

This Paper shall be of general nature, intended to assess the teaching / research aptitude of the candidate. It will primarily be designed to test reasoning ability, comprehension, divergent thinking and general awareness (relating to Karnataka state geographical, climate, environment, historical, political, social, economic, education and technological knowledge) of the candidate.

In the event of candidate attempting more than fifty questions, the first fifty questions attempted by the candidate would be evaluated and within that if grace marks awarded at later stage before declaration of the results to any question even if the candidate unattempted then such questions will also included in the count while counting the first 50 questions.

Paper-II: Subject Paper:

This Paper shall consist of questions based on the subject selected by the candidate. Each paper will consist of a Test Booklet containing 50 compulsory Multiple-choice questions (MCQ) of two marks each and maximum marks will be 100.

Paper-III: Subject paper (in depth questions):

This Paper will consist of 75 Multiple-choice (MCQ) compulsory questions from the subject selected by the candidates. Each question will carry two marks and maximum marks will be 150.

PROCEDURE and CRITIRIA FOR DECLARATION OF KSET RESULT:

This will comprise the following steps for considering a candidate for the eligibility for lectureship:

Stage 1: The candidates are required to obtain minimum marks separately in Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III as stated below, such candidates only will be considered for merit list.

Stage 2: Merit list prepared subject-wise and category-wise using the aggregate marks (total marks of all the three papers) obtained.

Stage 3: From the merit list prepared in Stage 2, top 15% candidates (in each subject and in each category) will be declared as KSET qualified for eligibility for Lectureship.

It may be noted that the above qualifying criteria decided by KSET is final and binding.

SYLLABUS AND QUESTION PAPER FOR KSET:

- a) **Syllabus:** Syllabus for KSET examination will be the same as in UGC/CSIR-NET. Syllabi for all the KSET subjects can be downloaded from the KSET website http://kset.uni-mysore.ac.in. The KSET center, Mysore will not send the syllabus to the candidates individually.
- b) In case of any discrepancy found in the Kannada translation of a question booklet the question in English version shall be taken as final.

- (I) The candidates who have completed / appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree in Economics / Co-operation & other related subjects can also take KSET examination under "Economics".
- (II) The candidates who have completed / appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree /PG Diploma in Management & other related subjects can also take KSET examination under "Management".
- (III) The candidates who have completed/appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree in Physics/Electronics/Atomic & Molecular Physics/Classical Dynamics/ Condensed matter Physics/Electromagnetic/ Experimental Design/Nuclear, Space & Particle Physics /Quantum Physics /Thermodynamics, Astronomy, Astrophysics/ Material Science and other related subjects can take KSET examination under "Physical Sciences".
- (IV) The candidates who have completed/appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree in Pure Mathematics / Statistics / Applied Mathematics, & other related subjects can take KSET examination under "Mathematical Sciences".
- (V) The candidates who have completed/ appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree in Chemistry / Chemical Sciences / Analytical Chemistry / Inorganic Chemistry / Organic Chemistry / Physical Chemistry / Medicinal Chemistry / Applied Chemistry / Nuclear Chemistry / Environmental Chemistry / Marine Chemistry / Pharmaceutical Chemistry / Bio-organic Chemistry/ polymer science & other related subjects can take KSET examination under "Chemical Sciences".
- (VI) The candidates who have completed / appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree in Biochemistry / Biology / Biotechnology / Biodiversity & Taxonomy / Botany / Genetics / Microbiology / Physiology/ Zoology / Fishery science / Animal Biology / Marine Biology / Applied Genetics / Sericulture & other related can take KSET examination under "Life Sciences".

- (VII) The candidates who have completed/appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree in Geology / Applied Geology / Geo-physics / Meteorology / Oceanography / Physical Geography / Earth Science / Earth & Atmospheric Science / Earth Science Resource Management / Marine Geology / Petroleum Geology / Geo-informatics / GIS / Applied Geochemistry / Geography & other related subjects can take KSET examination under "Earth Sciences".
- (VIII) The candidates who have completed / appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree in Archeology, Ancient History and Archeology & other related subjects can also take KSET examination under "Archeology".
- (IX) The candidates who have completed / appearing in their Two Year Master's Degree in Women Studies, Rural Development & other related subjects can also take KSET examination under "Women Studies".

Note: Please note that students who have passed post graduate examination in more than one subject can appear for KSET examination only in one subject at a time. Subject once selected is final and will not be allowed for change of subject under any circumstances.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1) Candidates seeking admission to KSET 2016 examination must apply online through KSET web site http://kset.uni-mysore.ac.in.
- 2) Before proceeding to apply candidates must possess a scanned passport size photo in JPEG format (4.5cm x 3.5cm) memory should not exceed 200 Kbytes.
- 3) Candidates should register (sign up for registration) giving required E-mail id & password. (Note: Candidate should note down and remember their E-mail ID and password till the announcement of final results of KSET 2016 examination). Candidates then proceed to give their personal, educational and KSET exam details, while mentioning their educational qualification they should mention their PG course as Passed or appearing as the case may be.
- 4) Candidates after successful online registration giving personal, educational and KSET-16 examination details. They can proceed for making payment of examination Fee by opting either **cash payment** or **online payment**. Candidates who choose for cash payment can take the printout of PAY IN SLIP and make payment in any of the CANARA **BANK CASH COUTERS only** and those who opt for online payment they can choose DEBIT CARD, CREDIT CARD, NETBANKING or NEFT and make payment. After successful payment candidates can take the hard copy of the e-challan provided by the CANARA BANK or a receipt generated from web for online payment.
- 5) After paying the necessary fee candidates have to login with their registered email ID and password FOR DOWNLOADING THE APPLICATION FORM AND CAN TAKE the printout of the 3 sheets of application form (hard copy) in A-4 size paper as detailed below;

 to be submitted to the Nodal center chosen by the candidate
 - 3. Admission card} to be retained by the candidate
- 6) Hard copy of the application form should be submitted to the respective Nodal center along with e-Challan (for Cash Payment) or receipt generated through web (online payment) along with attested copies of:
 - a. SSLC Marks Card
 - b. SC, ST, PWD (VH/PH), Cat-I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB category certificates
 - c. Proof of qualifying examination certificate and final PG Degree Marks Card. (For those who apply under appearing may submit the same after passing the qualifying examination).

Affix his/her pass port size photo at the place indicated on the hard copy of application form and Attendance slip must sign across the photograph. It should also duly be attested by the gazetted officer with seal.

- 7) Candidates should compulsorily submit the hard copy of application along with all other related documents in an A4 size cover, super scribed as [Application for KSET 2016], within the last date for submission. Application received after the last date will not be considered.
- 8) Printout of admission card should be retained by the candidate and bring on the day of examination. NO Admission card will be issued separately either by the Nodal centers or by KSET center. Candidates should compulsorily bring the valid Photo i.d. to the examination center without fail.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The candidates must read the conditions of eligibility carefully and must satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the Test before filling the online application and submit the printout of online application forms to their respective test centers.
- 2. KSET center may change the examination center (s) or date of examination without assigning any reason.
- 3. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for appearing for the Test.
- 4. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidature.
- 5. Candidates should correspond only with the NODAL officers (Name and address are given in the website http://kset.uni-mysore.ac.in) of respective university test centers opted by the candidate for any other relevant information.
- 6. Persons With Disability (PWD-Visually Handicapped (VH) / Physically Handicapped) candidates should attach the attested copy of <u>Medical Certificate issued by District Civil Surgeon</u>.
- 7. Applications submitted on any other format will not be accepted.
- 8. Candidates should ensure that the signatures appended and photographs pasted by them in all the places, viz. in their Application Form and Attendance Slip should be identical and there should be no variation of any kind.
- 9. The candidates in their own interest are advised to retain copies of the Application Form, Admission Card, Attendance Slip and e-challan/receipt for their record. This will be useful for candidates for any clarification with KSET Center.
- 10. Printout of online application form should NOT be sent directly to the Co-ordinator, KSET center, University of Mysore, Mysore.
- 11. Applications received after the last date at the respective test center will not be accepted.
- 12. Submission of Online Application is mandatory. Hard copies submitted to the Nodal Officer of the different centers without online submission, will not be accepted.

- 13. Application Form must be completed in all respect as per the Notification and declaration should be signed. Candidates who have NOT signed the declaration on their application will be rejected.
- 14. Applications failing to provide the following information's / attested documents will be REJECTED.
- a) Correct Test Center.
- b) Correct subject.
- c) Correct category along with Valid category certificates such as SC, ST, PWD (VH/PH), cat-1, IIA, IIB, IIIA and IIIB.

Candidates who do not submit their correct category certificates along with hard copy of application form their results will be withheld.

[Note: Category mentioned in the online submission of application form is final; any change in category sought in future will not be entertained for any reason]

- 15. All incomplete Application Forms will be totally rejected.
- 16. A candidate who does NOT appear for Paper-I and Paper-II will NOT be permitted to appear for Paper-III.
- 17. There will be no negative marking.
- 18. The use of calculators or Log Tables is not permitted. Cellular phones, pagers and any short of electronic devices etc., are not allowed in the Examination Hall/Room.
- 19. Candidates will not be allowed to write anything on the Admission Card or on any other paper.
- 20. Candidates should be present in the examination hall at 9.00 am in first session and at 1.00 pm in the second session. No candidates should be <u>allowed to</u> Examination hall / room after 10.00 a.m. in the first session and 2.00 p.m. in the second session. No candidates should be allowed <u>to leave</u> the Examination hall / room before 11.45a.m. in the first session and 3.30 p.m. in the second session.
- 21. The candidate will have to mark the responses for questions of paper I, Paper II & paper III only on the Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheet provided along with the test booklet.

 Candidates should mark the Booklet Series Code (W,X,Y,Z) in OMR sheet of Paper I & II, failing which Paper I will not be evaluated.
- 22. The candidate shall have to return the original OMR sheet of Paper-I and II, Paper-III to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall/room. However, candidates are allowed to take away the Test Booklet of Paper-I, II and III along with duplicate copy (carbonless copy) of OMR sheet.
- 23. For PWD candidates (VH/PH) 30 minutes extra time will be provided separately for Paper-I and Paper-II, 45 minutes extra time shall be provided for Paper III. The services of a scribe (a graduate in other than that f the candidate subject) will be provided for VH candidates and in case of PH candidates who are not in a position to write in their own handwriting. Such of those VH/PH (PWD) candidates seeking services of scribes have to make a written request (at least 10 days before the date of KSET examination) to the Nodal officer of the respective test center opted by the candidate. Those candidates who

- opt for their own scribe have to produce the scribe along with her/his certificates of educational qualification at least 10 days before the test date. Extra time and facility of scribe would not be provided to other Physically Handicapped candidates.
- 24. The detailed instructions for the candidates will be uploaded on the KSET website http://kset.uni-mysore.ac.in. Candidates may please see the instructions regarding use of text booklets, OMR sheet and specimen copy of OMR sheet from the KSET website. It may be noted that instructions to candidates will not be send to the candidates either by post or by email.
- 25. KSET will not issue any marks sheets to qualified / non qualified candidates.
- 26. There is no provision for re-evaluation or re-totaling.
- 27. The decision of the KSET Authorities shall be final in all matters.
- 28. The candidates who had sought clarifications for Provisional Key Answers and still having any grievances with regard to Final answer key(s) and after declaration of result, he/she may further challenge the final key answers with a written request and a Demand Draft of Rs.5,000/- in favour of Co-ordinator, KSET center, Pareeksha Bhavan, University of Mysore, Mysore 570 005, within 15days from the date of declaration of KSET -2016 examination result.
