Online Submission of NATA score and Marks in Qualifying Examination

Candidates who have applied for admission to Bachelor of Architecture Degree Course (B.Arch) 2015 should submit the details of their NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) Score with NATA-Candidate ID and marks obtained in the Qualifying Examination on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in The website will be open from 25.05.2015 to 06.06.2015, 5 pm for submission of marks online.

In order to submit the marks online, candidates will have to enter their Application number and Roll number through the link [KEAM 2015-Candidate Portal](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in to login to their Home page. Then by clicking on the Menu Item 'Mark Submission' and by providing Key number and Password (which they have already used while submitting online application for KEAM 2015), the candidates can submit their marks online. The candidates who have applied online for KEAM 2015 and remitted the Application Fee by way of Demand Draft (DD) can download and print their 'Key Number' by clicking on 'Print Key Number' button and by providing the Password after logging into their Home Page.

The candidates will have to submit the NATA score with the NATA-Candidate ID and the marks obtained in the Qualifying Examination. If the Qualifying Examination is Plus Two or equivalent, the total marks obtained for Mathematics and all other subjects need to be entered along with the Maximum marks, Register number and Year of passing. If the candidate has studied Diploma in Engineering as the Qualifying Examination, the total marks secured (in all the 3 years) along with Maximum mark, Register number and Year of passing need be entered. The submitted marks should be confirmed by the candidate by clicking on 'I Confirm and Submit' button and the printout of the 'Marks Data Sheet' should be taken. The candidate shall have to forward this printout duly signed along with the self attested copies of NATA score card and the mark sheets of Qualifying Examination directly or by way of post (Speed post/Registered post) to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, 5th Floor, Housing Board Buildings, Santhi Nagar, Thiruvananthapuram-695001 so as to reach him before 5 pm on 06.06.2015.

Candidates who have applied for Engineering Course in addition to Architecture should submit the marks separately for Architecture and Engineering after clicking the Menu Item 'Mark Submission' and the printouts of Mark Data Sheet for Architecture and Engineering are to be taken separately. The Mark Data Sheet for Engineering duly signed by the candidate along with the self attested copy of mark list is to be forwarded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Similarly, the Mark Data Sheet for Architecture duly signed by the candidate along with the self attested copies of mark list and NATA score card are to be forwarded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations separately for Architecture.

Applicants who do not submit the marks online and who do not forward the duly signed printout of the 'Marks Data Sheet' along with the self attested copies of the mark list of the Qualifying Examination and NATA Score Card will not be considered for preparation of rank list for Architecture Course 2015.
