

SET Test for Symbiosis Undergraduate Programmes

Symbiosis Entrance Test Overview

Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) is a common written test for the admission processes of undergraduate institutes of Symbiosis International University established as under Section 3 of the UGC Act 1956 vide notification No.F.9.12/2001 U.3 of the Govt. of India. In the year 2002 there were 3 constituent institutes of SIU. Subsequently ten more Institutes of Symbiosis have been brought under the ambit of Symbiosis International University vide notification No.F.9.12/2006-U.3 (A).

It is a mandatory written test for the admission process for the undergraduate programmes of the following Symbiosis institutes namely:-

- 1. Symbiosis Law School.[SLS] Pune
- 2. Symbiosis Law School. [SLS] Noida
- 3. Symbiosis Institute of Computers Studies and Research [SICSR]
- 4. Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies[SCMS] Pune
- 5. Symbiosis Institute of Media & Communication [SIMC-UG]
- 6. Symbiosis School of Economics [SSE]
- 7. Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies[SCMS]-Noida
- 8. Symbiosis Institute of Design [SID]

However, SET is not mandatory for the Symbiosis institute of Technology (SIT), Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences (SIHS), Symbiosis College of Nursing (SCON) and Symbiosis School of Liberal Arts (SSLA).

Note: Candidates those who are applying to Symbiosis Institute of Technology (SIT) and Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences (SIHS), Symbiosis School of Nursing (SCON) and Symbiosis School of Liberal Arts (SSLA) should visit their websites for further details.

Candidate should note that SET is only the first step. Each Symbiosis institute has its independent selection process.

- SET-2014 has 5 different papers; namely, General, Design, Law, Engineering and Health Sciences.
- The test will be conducted in two sessions, morning and afternoon.
- A candidate may take more than one paper. However, he will have to choose one paper from morning session and one paper from afternoon session.

A candidate aspiring to pursue an undergraduate programme at Symbiosis should carefully follow the actions to be taken in 3 stages mentioned below:

Stage-1: SET Test

- Register online at <u>www.set-test.org</u>
- You may register for one paper in the morning; viz, **Law** or **Design** and one paper in the afternoon session; viz, **Engineering, General or Health Sciences.**

For Engineering and Health Sciences, if a candidate wishes to offer scores other than SET, he/she need not register for SET and apply directly to the concerned institute.

- You need to upload your latest scanned photograph at the time of registration.
- Follow the instructions for payment of test fee of **Rs. 1500/-** on the SET website. This includes charges for prospectus of the undergraduate programmes at Symbiosis International University.
- Print "admit card" directly from the SET website from April 21, 2014 onwards.
- Bring the admit card and a photo identity to the test centre. It will be authenticated during the Test.

(Candidates shall preserve the authenticated admit card till the admission processes of the desired Symbiosis institutes are over. If the admit card is lost, no duplicate admit card will be issued.)

• Appear for the test.

Stage-2: Apply online to the desired SIU's constituent institutes.

- The SET website (<u>www.set-test.org</u>) allows a facility to directly apply online to an institute.
- Candidates may also apply from the institute's website.
- To apply for admission to an institute, a candidate must register for the relevant SET paper. For example, to apply to Symbiosis Law School, register for Law paper at SET.
- Candidates applying to Symbiosis Institute of Technology (SIT), Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences (SIHS), Symbiosis College Of Nursing (SCON) or Symbiosis School of Liberal Arts [SSLA] with other than SET-2014 score should refer to the respective institute websites and apply.

Stage-3: Attend further selection process of the chosen institutes, if invited.

- Each institute has its own cutoff, as mentioned in the prospectus.
- The institutes will announce short listed candidates for attending further selection process.
- The individual institute as per their schedules will announce short listed candidates list & waiting list.
- For details of selection process and schedules, please refer to the website of respective institute(s).

Important

- While adequate care is taken in ensuring that there are no mistakes in reading the answer sheet by the scanning machine, there is no provision of revaluation of the answer sheet of any candidate.
- The scores published by the Symbiosis Test Secretariat shall be final and shall not be subject to any appeal or revaluation.
- The SET score card will be available on the website for a period of one month from the date of declaration of results i.e. from May 19, 2014 to June 20, 2014.
- Those candidates paying through cash or DD, should ensure that,
 - 1. Bank challan for cash payment, (Axis Bank/Indian Bank) or

• To complete registration process, a candidate is required to register online for SET Test at <u>www.set-test.org</u> and appear for the test. It is also mandatory to complete registration by filling up the on line application form of desired institute for desired programme before the closing date of application for the respective institute.

- a. **Duration:** SET duration is 150 minutes.
- b. SET is an objective test.
- c. **Papers**: SET is conducted in two sessions for FIVE question papers. A candidate may apply to take one paper from each session.
- d. Institutes: The constituent institutes use scores of the following for admission.

SET is an aptitude test and objective in nature for all the papers. Each question has four options as answers. There is no negative marking for wrong answers. All sections are mandatory.

How to Register For SET – 2014?

- Step 1. A candidate can register for one paper from the morning session; viz, Law or Design and one paper from the afternoon session; viz, General or Engineering or Health Sciences Register at <u>www.set-test.org</u> This will generate your SET ID. You need to upload your latest scanned photograph (in the given format and size) at the time of online registration.
- **Step 2.** Pay a non-refundable fee of Rs. 1500/- towards the test fee and for prospectus of undergraduate programmes of Symbiosis International University. The SIU Admission Cell will courier a copy of prospectus to the address registered at <u>www.set-test.org</u>

Candidates have four (4) choices for payment as follows,

1. CASH:

- This 'Payment Advice' form is in three parts. Pay Rs. 1500/- in cash at Axis Bank or Indian Bank branches in your city. Refer to the list of branches on the website. The bank will return two parts of the 'payment advice' form to you. The 'student copy' is your receipt.

Step 3. Important instructions regarding Admit Card

- 2. Admit Card along with Photo Identity proof should be carried to the Test Centre at the time of the test. An acceptable photo identity is any one of the following,
 - Passport.
 - Driving license.
 - College/ Institute Identity Card.
 - Credit card with photograph.
 - Voter ID Card.
 - Pan Card
 - AADHAR Card (UID)
- 3. Please ensure that your latest passport size, colour photograph is pasted on the Admit Card at the place provided for and duly attested by **Gazetted Officer** before appearing for test.
- 4. An authorized person from Symbiosis International University will verify and authenticate your Admit Card against the photo-id. Please preserve this authenticated Admit Card for further PI-WAT processes.
- 5. Candidates should note that an authenticated Admit Card is an important document without which the candidate will not be permitted to appear for further selection processes of SIU. How to apply to Undergraduate Institutes of Symbiosis International University?

You may apply online for admission to an undergraduate institute of the University. The application fee is Rs. 1000/- per institute, except for SICSR. (The application fee for SICSR is Rs. 1000/- for one programme and Rs.2000/- for two programmes).

There are two options to apply for admission to an institute:-

1. From SET website.

While paying SET fees online, a candidate may also pay the application fee for admission to a desired institute.

Even after closing of the payment for SET, a candidate may still apply through SET website.

2. From the institute website.

A candidate may also register separately for SET and applying to an institute. However, SET registration and appearing for the test is mandatory.

It is important to see that a candidate appears for the appropriate SET paper to seek admission.

An institute may also be offering more than one programme. A candidate should ensure the desired programme is selected.

You **cannot** apply to an institute that does not accept the score of the test that you choose to give. For example, if you choose to give the General test <u>only</u>, you cannot apply to SLS. Similarly, if you choose to give the Law test <u>only</u>, you cannot apply to SSE or SCMS (UG) or SICSR.

You may give both tests and apply to all the four institutes.

Similarly, you may give the Design test and the Engineering/ Health Sciences test and also apply to SID, SIT, SIHS and SCON.

After declaration of the SET result, the institute to which you have applied will conduct further selection process for short listed candidates. The schedule for the same will be published on the websites of the institute.

Reservation Policy

As per the UGC guideline 2006, the reservation policy for all the institutes under the University is as given below:-

Within the sanctioned intake

SC - 15 % ST - 7.5 % Differently Abled - 3 %

Over and above the intake

Kashmir Migrants – 2 seats per programme International Students – 15 %

Defence Quota – 5 % for SLS-PUNE and SICSR.

Note: Candidate applying for the above mentioned categories will be required to submit the supporting documents at the time of PI-WAT.

Note: The mechanism and the related process for Personal Interaction and Writing Ability Test (PI-WAT) will be updated soon.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Symbiosis Centre for International Education takes care of International Students aspiring for admission to the Constituent Institutes of Symbiosis International University.

Categories listed under International Students Admissions:

Foreign National (FN):

A student is eligible to apply as a Foreign National (FN), if he/she holds a foreign passport.

Person of Indian Origin (PIO):

A student is eligible to apply as a Person of Indian Origin (PIO), if he/she has a PIO card, and is a citizen of a country other than India.

Non Resident Indian (NRI):

A student is eligible to apply as a Non Resident Indian (NRI), if he/she has appeared either for the 10 or 10+2 (equivalent to the Indian $10^{th} \& 12^{th}$) examination outside India.

It is mandatory for the student who falls in the NRI Category and has appeared for 12^{th} in India to appear for the SET TEST.

INTRODUCTION

- iii. Foreign Nationals (FN), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) & NRIs.
- iv. Diploma holders of International Baccalaureate (IB): IB Diploma Students with predicted scores may also apply: IB students are exempt for SET since their final exams clash with the SET exam dates.
- v. XII (10+2) pass from any branch with minimum 50% marks for the general category and 45% for students of SC and ST category.

Reservation policy as per university norms.

Intake.

Every year, 60 students are invited to join our college + over and above reservation for international students as per SIU policy. In case the SSLA campus shifts to Viman Nagar as per the current plan, the yearly intake will increase to 100 students per year + over and above reservation for international students are per SIU policy.

Admission Process (Additional point added by SSLA into Bulletin)

In keeping with the accepted SSLA admissions process from 2012, SSLA has a slightly differing admissions process for International Baccalaureate (IB) students. The details of the SSLA admissions process for normal and for IB students are as given below:

For all Indian Nationals graduating 12th in India:

- Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET)
- Recommended Test: SET General. However, candidates who have given Law / Design SET will also be considered if they have not given General SET for any reason However, these applicants will only be considered if they fall in the top 100 of their respective Law / Design SET rankings.
- Cut off for General SET will be decided as per the applications that SSLA receives.
- SET = 50 Marks (i.e. 50 % of total which is as per SIU guidelines)
- Personal Interaction & Writing Ability Test (PI-WAT)
- Both will be conducted on the same day for a particular student.
- PI = 30 Marks, WAT = 20 Marks (Total PI-WAT = 50 Marks)
- Merit List
- SET (50) + PI (30) + WAT (20) = 100 Marks

For International Baccalaureate (IB) students

- All IB students are exempt from SET in keeping with the policy SSLA has been following since 2012. This is because SET clashes with IB exam dates.
- Since they do not appear for SET, all IB applicants will be called for PI-WAT.
- Apart from the personal interaction and writing ability test, these students will be required to sit for a test that will make up for their lack of SET score. This test will count for 50 Marks (i.e. 50% of total) and therefore will be in line with SIU UG admissions guidelines.
- Personal Interaction & Writing Ability Test (PI-WAT)
 - Both will be conducted on the same day for a particular student. As written above, the additional test will also be conducted on the same day.
 - PI = 30 Marks, WAT = 20 Marks (Total PI-WAT = 50 Marks)
 - Merit List
 - IB Students Test (50) + PI (30) + WAT (20) = 100 Marks
 - Merit Lists will be created in a consolidated manner for IB and Non-IB students. There will be no separate merit list only for IB students.
