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Clarification

In pursuance of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in the case of P. A. Inamdar v/s State of Maharashtra & others 2005 (6) SCC 537, Unaided Private Ayurved Medical Colleges in the state of Maharashtra have a right to admit students and to hold common entrance test, Therefore at this stage admissions to all the seats in the Unaided Ayurvedic Medical Colleges will be done as per merit of Asso-PGA-CET-2015 except 15% NRI seats. For the admission to P.G. courses in Ayurveda for the academic year 2015-2016 has been permitted by the PNS.

As per the aforesaid judgment and the decision of the Hon. Pravesh Niyantran Samiti, there is 50% management quota including 15% NRI Quota at the discretion of the member colleges. Particulars regarding the same will be displayed on the official website of AMAMCM.

The programe mentioned in this brochure is applicable to the Postgraduate admissions to be given for the academic year 2015-16 at the Unaided Private Ayurvedic Medical Colleges in the state of Maharashtra & All of Ayurveda courses.

However, it is made amply clear that after publication of the brochure, if there is any order by appropriate authority or any legislation or judgment by any court of law, then the AMAMCM will abide by the appropriate order/ enactment/ judgment, reserving its right to challenge and without prejudice to rights as per the TMA Pai Foundation (2002) 8 SCC 481 & P A Inamdar's case (Hon. Supreme Court) judgments.

Association Post Graduate Ayurved – Common Entrance Test – 2015

1. INTRODUCTION:

The entrance examination for the Post Graduate Courses in the private unaided Ayurved College in the State of Maharashtra for the Academic year 2015-16 shall be conducted by the Competent Authority appointed by the **Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra (AMAMCM)** pursuant to directions issued in judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in para 137 of P.A. Inamdar versus State of Maharashtra. The entrance examination shall be conducted for all seats except in the private unaided Ayurved Colleges.

2. COMPETENT AUTHORITY:

Competent Authority Dr. Virendra Kalyanrao Meenkire is appointed by the AMAMCM. The Competent Authority will supervise the conduct of Asso-PGS-CET-2015 and also supervise evaluation of answers and declaration of results & merit list. The Competent Authority will issue necessary executive instruction for implementation of these rules and provide relevant information to be published and communicated. The Management of Association will be fully responsible for evaluation of sheets, declaration of results and merit list and conduct of examination. Competent authority will be present as and when required in the office.

3. NUMBER OF SEATS:

The list of postgraduate courses available is given in **Annexure- A** and the number of seats in the respective Colleges is given in **Annexure-E**

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

M.D./M.S. Ayurved Courses

- 4.1 The candidate must be an Indian National.
- 4.2 A candidate who has passed final B.A.M.S. Examination or equivalent qualification in Ayurved included in the second schedule appended to the CCIM act, 48 of 1970 & are covered under parts "A", "A-I", "B", "C" Schedule appended to MMP Act, 1961 and passed the qualifying examination from the state of Maharashtra (Except for out of state category) and has completed one year rota or internship will be eligible to appear for Asso-PGA-CET -2015.
- 4.3 The provisional/permanent MCIM registration or CCIM registration is a condition precedent for appearing at Asso-PGA-CET-2015 and its proof including submission of application for registration should be enclosed.
- 4.4 A candidate who has completed one year compulsory internship or is likely to Complete the same on or before 31/10/2015 can appear for Asso-PGA-CET-2015.

- 4.5 Candidates likely to complete their internship on or before commencement of first round should submit documentary proof from their principals / Dean of the college regarding the likely date of completion of internship. Candidate will be fully responsible for submitting correct information in the application form.
- 4.6 Candidates who are previously registered and pursuing / completed the course are not eligible for appearing at Asso-PGA-CET-2015. Candidates who have completed PG Diploma is eligible to appear for the Asso-PGA-CET-2015 for admission to PG Degree in the same subject only.
- 4.7 Candidate should keep one photo copy of his / her application form duly filled in with him / her for future reference.
- 4.8 Candidate should preserve the (i) Receipt-cum-identity card (ii) Information brochure for subsequent use.
- 4.9 Candidate in open category must obtain minimum 50% or more marks in Asso-PGA-CET-2015 and 40% in case of constitutional reservation in Asso-PGA-CET-2015.

5. CANDIDATES NOT ELIGIBLE FOR APPEARING:

Following candidates are not eligible for applying to Asso-PGA-CET-2015:

- 5.1 Candidates who are not completing internship on or before 31/10/2015
- 5.2 Candidates who are registered for PG Degree and have not completed the terms.
- 5.3 Candidates who are previously registered and pursuing / completed the PG degree Course or have obtained PG degree within three years.

Note: The candidates who have not obtained permanent CCIM / MCIM registration, at the time of submission of application form along with those who will be completing internship by 31/10/2015 such candidates will have to submit proof or receipt of application at the time of first round.

6. APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 6.1 The candidate is required to go through the Information Brochure carefully and acquaint him /herself with all the requirements with regard to filling in of application form.
- 6.2 An applicant seeking admission and willing to appear for Asso-PGA-CET-2015 will be required to submit the application in a prescribed form. Which can be obtained along with information brochure .
- 6.3 Information brochure along with blank application form will be available at the office of AMAMCM, Mumbai & notified centers as per **annexure-B** on payment of prescribed fees of Rs.1000/-by D.D. drawn on favour of AMAMCM, payable at Islampur drawn on a nationalised / scheduled Bank. Application form will also be available from office of the Association by post with an additional DD of Rs. 200/- for postal charges.
- 6.4 The application form must be filled in by the candidate in his / her own handwriting using black ballpoint pen. The application form complete in all respect shall be submitted directly to the office of AMAMCM, Mumbai either in person or by post or courier. The filled in application is to be duly returned along with the common Entrance test fees for Asso-PGA-CET-2015. Rs.3000/- which shall be paid by DD in favour of AMAMCM, payable at Islampur drawn on a nationalised / scheduled Bank at the time of submission of application form. Application must be accompanied by the self addressed and stamp envelop along with receipt-cum-identity card (**Annexure - C**) for acknowledgement.

- 6.5 Asso-PGA-CET-2015 will be conducted at Mumbai,only.
- 6.6 No original documents to be attached with the application form. Only attested photo copies of all the mark list of first to final BAMS examinations and candidate in reserved category to the CVC & Non cremylear if applicable are required to be submitted along with the manual application form (**Annexure I**). However, the certificates in original and their attested photo copies are mandatory and must be produced for verification and submitted at the time of admission along with the prescribed fees. However, the certificates in original and their attested photo copies are mandatory and must be produced for verification and submitted at the time of admission along with the prescribed fees.
- 6.7 Candidate will receive the admit card which is available on our web site www.amamcm.org on or before 10/08/2015.
- 6.8 Incomplete application forms will be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- 6.9 The official at the AMAMCM office while accepting the application form shall issue the Receipt -cum- Identity card attesting the photograph of the candidate with signature and stamp.
- 6.10 The candidate is required to preserve the receipt-cum-identity card and admit card for all future and reference & correspondence.
- 6.11 The candidate shall submit one and only one application form. In case candidate submits more than one application form, he/she shall be disqualified for appearing for
- 6.12 The Association will not be responsible for Postal delays.
- 6.13 Candidate should fill up the application form stating their preference of Asso-CET-2015 exam centre as stated in Rule 6.5

7. CONDUCT OF Asso-PGA-CET-2015.

- 7.1 All the eligible candidates are required to take the Asso-PGA-CET- 2015 at their own cost.
- 7.2 The Asso-PGA-CET- 2015 will be conducted on 16/08/15 between 2 pm-5 pm. The candidate should report 30 minutes before i.e. 01.30 p.m. on exam centre.
- 7.3 The Asso-PGA-CET- 2015 will be conducted at Mumbai only.
- 7.4 The examination will be conducted in English, Marathi and Hindi Languages.
- 7.5 Asso-PGA-CET- 2015 paper will be of three hours duration containing 250 Multiple choice Questions (MCQs). Questions will be of single best response objective type with four answer options. Each correct response shall be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers. Scratching, overwriting, tick mark multiple answers will be considered as wrong answers and no marks are awarded to them.
- 7.6 The candidate will write the required information regarding Roll No. etc. on Answer sheet as well as on the question booklet with black boll point pen only.

7.7 The Common Entrance Test shall be of the standard of B.A.M.S. Examination (Total syllabus) and shall cover all the subjects of B.A.M.S. Course. The tentative number of questions of each subject will be as given below:

8. DECLARATION OF RESULT :

- 8.1 The Competent Authority shall conduct Asso-PGA-CET- 2015 and get the answer - sheets evaluated and prepare the Merit list/
- 8.2 The Competent Authority, Asso-PGA-CET- 2015 will prepare a Merit list indicating Merit number, Name, Marks scored by the candidates.
- 8.3 The Provisional Merit list will be available only on AMAMCM website only on **22/08/2015**
- 8.4 The statement of marks of the candidate indicating marks obtained and merit number of the candidate will be dispatched by Post.
- 8.5 The candidate who wants duplicate mark sheet will have to apply to the Competent Authority with prescribed fees of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) paid by D.D. drawn in favor of AMAMCM payable at Islampur.
- 8.6 There will be no rechecking/revaluation of the answer sheets. However the candidate can apply for **verification of marks** to the Competent Authority Asso-PGA-CET- 2015 directly on or before **29/08/2015** in prescribed form (**Annexure- D**) along with prescribed fees of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) to be paid by Demand Draft in favor of "AMAMCM" payable at Islampur The Competent Authority provides Photo copy of answer sheet & answer key of candidate by post.
- 8.7 After verification of marks final merit list will be displayed on website on **03/08/2015**.

9. PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST

- 9.1 To be eligible for selection to 50% merit seats of the total in PG **Ayurved** Courses a candidate belonging to open category must secure not less than 50% marks and a candidate belonging to reserve category must secure not less than 40% marks at Asso-PGA-CET-2015.
- 9.2 **Distribution of seats** – 50% of the total seats will be filled from student category with on merit of Asso-PGA-CET-2015 which will include 25% of reservation quota. And remaining 50% of the total seats will be filled in by the management from candidates fulfilling the norms which will include 15% of the total seats for as NRI Quota.
- 9.3 **TIE-BREAKER: Determination of the inter-se merit of candidates obtaining equal Asso-PGA-CET-2015 marks:** In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the Asso-PGA-CET-2015, the inter-se merit of such candidates will be determined in the order of preference as under.
- 9.3.1 The Candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at First, Second, Third B.A.M.S. Examination taken together shall be preferred.
- 9.3.2 The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Final B.A.M.S. Examination will be preferred.
- 9.3.3 The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage) at Second B.A.M.S. Examination will be preferred .
- 9.3.4 The older candidate will be preferred.
- 9.4 The statement of marks of the candidate indicating Merit Number, Name, Marks Scored, will be dispatched on the address filled in the application form by the candidate.
- 9.5 In case of any typographical error in mark sheet e.g. Name, Age, Sex, Category, etc. representation should be submitted within 24 hours from the date of distribution of mark-sheet to the Competent Authority, AMAMCM, Mumbai.
- 9.6 To be eligible for selection to 50% of the seats in PG Ayurvedic Courses a candidates will be selected from merit of Asso- PGA-CET-2015 as per direction issued in para 137 of P.A. Inamdar versus State of Karnataka reported in 2005 (6) SCC 537.

“admissions to students drawn otherwise than the source of only one CET does not satisfy the mandate contemplated by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in (2003) 6 Supreme Court cases 697 Islamic Academy of Education v. State of Karnataka Para No. 16 as re-produced hereunder:

" We thus hold that the management could select students, of their quota, either on the basis of the common entrance test conducted by the State or on the basis of a common entrance test to be conducted by an association of all colleges of a particular type in that State e.g. medical, engineering or technical etc. The common entrance test, held by the association, must be for admission to all colleges of that type in the State. The option of choosing, between either of these tests, must be exercised before issuing of prospectus and after intimation to the concerned authority and the Committee set up hereafter.

If any professional college chooses not to admit from the common entrance test conducted by the association then that college must necessarily admit from the common entrance test conducted by the State, After holding the common entrance test and declaration of results the merit 1st will immediately be placed on the notice-board of all colleges which have chosen to admit as per this test. A copy of the merit 1st will also be forthwith sent to the concerned authority and the Committee. **Selection of students & must then be strictly on the basis of merit as per that merit List'!"**

10. RESERVATION:

Constitutional Reservation required as per Government notification No MED-2006/1196/CR 204/06 EDU-1 dated 24/06/2006 the seats to be reserved for candidates belonging to the reserve category shall be 25% of the sanction intake capacity. The candidates recognized by the state of Maharashtra as belonging to the following backward classes shall alone be eligible admissions as against the seats reserved for such backward class categories. These backward class categories are as follows.

i. Scheduled castes and scheduled caste converts to Buddhism (SC)	6.50%
ii. Scheduled tribes (ST)	3.50%
iii. Vimukta Jati (VJ/DT-A)	1.50%
iv. Nomadic Tribes (NT-B) NT-1	1.25%
v. Nomadic Tribes (NT-C) NT-2	1.75%
vi. Nomadic Tribes (NT-D) NT-3	1.00%
vii. Other backward category (OBC) including SBC	9.50%
Total	25.00%

- 10.1. The candidate should have claimed the constitutional reservation in the original application form. The candidate claiming constitutional reservation must submit caste validity certificate issued by competent Government authority at time of counseling and admission. Failing the category claim earlier will not be granted later.
- 10.2. If seats are vacant in the reservation category, will made available from among the candidates of their **respective group** where the vacancies exist, by inter-se merit.
- 10.3. Candidates belonging to Non-Creamy layer Category will be required to submit the non-creamy layer Certificate issued on or after **31/03/2015** in the name of parent from the appropriate authorities of the Govt. of Maharashtra (G.R.No.CBC10/2006/CR-15/MVK-5,dt.30th June 2006).
- 10.4. As per the GR. fees paid by samaj kalyan office of Govt. of Maharashtra is only for SC category other reservations are consider only for merit preference.

- 10.5 If any vacancy of reserve category filled at college level as per GR of Maharashtra Govt. of March 2015 no Fees will be refunded to any reserve category including SC category by Samaj Kalyan Office, Govt. Maharashtra.

11. SELECTION PROCESS

- 11.1 The selection to a Course/College will be made as per Merit-Cum-Preference given by the candidate.
- 11.2 The Candidate desires of claiming constitutional reservation must claim the same in the preference form. A candidate belonging to reservation category must specify the name of the **reserved category** and must produce all the relevant documents, then Competent Authority will reserve seats for constitutional reservation if applicable as per the announcement of Government Ordinance whenever admissible.

The selection process shall be as follows:

- 11.3 The Preference form shall be given to the candidates immediately after the Asso-PGA-CET-2015 is over at the examination centre itself.
- 11.4 Eligible candidates from Asso-PGA-CET-2015 Merit List will be required to fill in the "Preference Form". The preference form should be submitted directly to the office of the AMAMCM on or before **24/09/2015** Preference form received after **24/09/2015** will not be considered. The Preference filled by the candidates will be centrally processed and the final merit list prepared. As per the Merit-cum-Preference the selection to be made and the list of selected candidate will be declared on the website. As per the declared Selection List the candidates should report to the allotted college and join in the specified period.
- 11.5 The list of subjects and college codes is provided in **Annexure- E**.
- 11.6 Subjects & Seat distribution Chart (**Annexure- F**): Contains distributions of available seats. The college wise & subject wise distribution will be made available on the website: www.amamcm.org. Distribution chart is subject to change as per instructions of University, as per availability/ non availability of PG Teachers etc.
- 11.7 **PREFERENCE FORM:** Candidate will collect the Preference Form after the examination is over on **16/08/2015** and fill in the relevant information along with his/her Roll Number, Merit Number, Asso-PGA-CET-2015 Marks and sent it to the AMAMCM. Preference Form should be handled carefully. Please do not fold, staple and spoil in any way as **Preference Forms are to be scanned**. Last date for submission of Preference form is **24/09/2015**.

- 11.8 Candidate will be issued only one Preference Form. Another Preference Form will not be issued to the candidate on any grounds.
- 11.9 In case the candidate is not eligible for admission according to the rules(candidates securing less than 50% marks(open category) and less than 40%marks (reserved category) need not fill in the preference forms). The Preference Form issued already, will be treated as cancelled. The non-eligible candidate need not to send the filled in forms to the AMAMCM office.
- 11.10 Candidate should read all instructions before filling the Preference Form. Candidate should carefully note the subjects and college code. The candidates are instructed to make two photo copies of the Preference Form, one photo copy may be used as specimen copy to fill in the same for practice. Once the candidate is satisfied with his/her filled in choices in the specimen copy, he/she may fill on the Preference Form provided by AMAMCM by using **Black Ball Point Pen**.
Second photo-copy will be retained by the candidate as his/her copy for record.
- 11.11 Candidate should write subject of Preference and college code numbers in the boxes. One digit in each box (4 digits in 4 boxes). Candidate should write the codes with Black Ball Point Pen with neat legible and clear handwriting. Please do not fold, staple, pin, the preference form as the form will be scanned by the computer.
- 11.12 Candidate can fill minimum 1 preference or any desired number or maximum preferences available. The same subject and college code should not be filled more than once. In case the candidate fills the same code more than once, higher Preference will be considered and subsequent repeated Preference Number will be ignored. If the candidate fills any wrong code of subject and college, it will be rejected.
- 11.13 If a candidate does not give Preference for a particular subject and college then it means that he / she is not interested in those subjects and college combinations. Candidates should note that there will be No Change / Addition / Deletion in the Preference at a later stage.
- 11.14 The Candidate selected as per his / her Merit cum Preference for a particular subject in the particular college, then he / she has to join the course as per procedure. In failure to join the allotted course in the stipulated time, he/she is debarred from subsequent admission process of Asso-PGA-CET-2015.
- 11.15 In case the candidate is not selected in the first round, then he/she remains eligible for the subsequent round for the preferences which he/she has given in the Preference Form.
- 11.16 For filling of vacant seats after first round **same** Preference Form will be considered and no separate Preference Form will be required to be filled in by the candidate.
- 11.17 Candidate should submit only one Preference Form, Submission of more than one Preference Form will lead to disqualification.
- 11.18 Candidate should note that the Preference of subject and college code once entered in the data shall be final and irrevocable. Thereafter, there can not be any change, addition or deletion of Preference entered by candidate. This final data shall be used in entire selection process for the admission to Postgraduate Courses.

12 SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- 12.1 The collected data will be centrally processed for the selection of candidates for P.G. Ayurved Courses.
- 12.2 The selection will be done as per Merit and Preference given by candidates in Preference Form.
- 12.3 The list of candidates selected for P.G. Ayurved Courses shall be displayed on the AMAMCM website: www.amamcm.org
- 12.4 The first selection list will be declared on **24/09/2015** on the website: www.amamcm.org of AMAMCM and the list of selected candidates will be sent to all concerned colleges. Candidates should report and pay the fees and submit all the original certificates with one set of attested photocopies of all the certificates, at the respective Colleges on or before **06/10/15**. No separate selection letter will be issued to the selected candidates.
- 12.5 If the Candidate does not report within this date, his/her selection stands cancelled and he / she will be debarred from the subsequent process.

13 FILLING OF VACANT SEATS:

- 13.1 After selection in first round if the candidate desires to retain the same selection (Subject & College) and does not want to take any further betterment then he/she can do so by filling '**Status Retention Form**' in prescribed Profarma (**Annexure- G**). Status Retention Form is to be submitted to the Competent Authority through the college only, where he/she is admitted. However, candidate should note that after filling status retention form, he/she will be deleted from the further selection process for the academic year **2015-15**.
- 13.2 After the first round, the vacant seats, if any, will be filled in the second round of selection on **13/10/15** by declaring the selection list on the website.: www.amamcm.org of AMAMCM. Selected candidates in second round will report to the respective college on or before **20/10/15** For these seats the selected as well as the not selected candidate who have filled in the Preference Form are eligible except those who have opted for status retention.
- 13.3 The candidate selected in the first round except the candidates who have submitted the status retention form as per procedure will be considered for betterment (higher preference exercised) in the subsequent round. The shift in such betterment shall be compulsory and mandatory. Such candidates will have to collect the original certificates and admissible refund of fees as per procedure mentioned in Asso-PGA-CET-2015 Brochure and join the New Course and college before **20/10/15**.
- 13.4 Candidate who has confirmed his / her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the concerned Dean.
- 13.5 Any seat remaining vacant after the second round of admission will be filled in by the specific college, inviting applications from eligible candidates
- 13.5.1 Selection of candidates after the second round shall be made strictly on the basis of final merit index calculated out of total of 100 Marks based on one common written test of Multiple Choice Questions conducted by each college at their level.

13.5.2 The minimum eligibility marks of the common written test for admission in the case of general candidates shall be fifty percent of the total marks and in the case of candidates belonging to the schedule Castes. Scheduled Tribes and Regular Government service candidate shall be forty percent.

13.6 Last date of admission process of filling vacant seats for Postgraduate Courses is **31/10/15**

13.7 The candidates must produce original certificates at the time of admission to the college and a set of attested photocopy of each of the document as per the list given below. The candidate should bring the following documents as per their admission as a Regular candidate:

- Proof of age – SSC Certificate,
- HSC Mark Memo & Certificate.
- Statement of Marks of 1st, 2nd & Final B.A.M.S. examinations.
- B.A.M.S. Degree/Passing Certificate.
- Attempt Certificate for all University Examinations.
- Internship Completion Certificate or Certificate indicating the likely date of completion of internship,
- Registration Certificate of M.C.I.M./C.C.I.M.
- College leaving Certificate,
- Education gap certificate after completing Internship
- Physical fitness Certificate,
- Admit Card & Statements of Marks of Asso-PGA-CET-2015. (Website copy)
- Caste Certificate and Caste validity certificate (where applicable).
- Non-creamy layer certificate(where applicable).

13.8 The registration once granted is valid only if the teacher and the Dean are satisfied about regularity, diligent persuasion of studies by the student as well as good conduct.

13.9 A candidate selected for Postgraduate Degree will not be allowed for change of subject.

13.10 In case of dispute in the matter of allotment of seat/ course / Institution or any other matter pertaining to the provisional selection or cancellation of admission, the decision of the management of the concerned institution shall be final and binding.

13.11 A candidate will have to deposit all his/her relevant original certificates, documents along with the complete tuition fees to the concerned college.

14. FEES:

Fees structure will be as per the declaration of Shikshan Shulka Samiti, other appropriate authorities, judicial pronouncement. The fees declare by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti is displayed on the official website of the Samiti. (www.sspmsamiti.gov.in)

15 REFUND OF FEES

- 15.1 Refund of fees by the College after change of College/course for higher preference by the Competent Authority for the same year, the deduction of Rs 2000/- from the tuition fees before the date of Joining of second round **13/10/2015.**
- After final round - no refund **20/10/2015.**
- 15.2 Candidate who has confirmed his/her admission wishes to cancel the admission for any other reason except betterment the refund of fees will be as follows
- Before the date of second round - Permissible deduction 30% of the remitted fee.
 - Before the last date of joining of second round - Permissible deduction 50% of the remitted fee.
 - After final round - no refund.
- 15.3 If a candidate expires or becomes invalid within three months from the date of admission, full refund Shall be made after deducting Rs 1000/- as administrative charges.
- 15.4 If a candidate cancels his/her admission after the cut off date he is subject to pay the fees for whole course.
- 15.5 Please, also note that refund off fees will be as per direction of Pravesh Niyantran Samiti from time to time.

16 DISCIPLINE:

- 16.1 Any candidate / authorized representative or accompanying person is Found obstructing the admission process, trying to influence in unlawful Manner /creating nuisance, the candidate shall be liable for disqualification from the process of selection. The decision taken by the Management in this respect shall be final and binding.
- 16.2 All candidates selected shall be subject to the disciplinary rules of the Institution, University, Government and Management.

17 LEGAL JURISDICTION:

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of examination and selection process shall fall within the jurisdiction of Mumbai High Court bench at Mumbai only or of the legal jurisdiction of the institution concerned.

18 DISQUALIFICATION OF ADMISSION:

After the cut of date no candidate will be allowed to change the subject ,college institute. In any case mutual transfer shall not be allowed during the course.

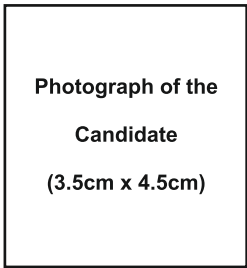
