REGULATIONS:

- 1. The following are the regulations for admission of students into M.Sc (Nursing) courses in Colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences for the academic session 2015-16.
- 2. Number of Seats: The number of seats for admission into first year M. Sc (Nursing) courses and number of seats in each course of study for service candidates and for regular (Non-Service) candidates for the academic year 2015-16 will be displayed prior to the counseling. The Regular (Non-Service) seats at Govt. College of Nursing, Hyderabad and the courses in Pvt. Nursing Colleges are Non-State wide courses.

Note: In case any new Colleges/Courses are affiliated for starting the M.Sc.,(Nursing) courses for the academic year 2015-16, the seats in those Colleges/Courses will also be filled up. NO FURTHER NOTIFICATION WILL BE ISSUED.

- 2.1 In accordance with the Memo No. 869/F2/85-2, M&H, dated 23-07-1985.
 - 2.1.1 M.Sc., (Nursing) courses for Service candidates at the college of Nursing, Hyderabad is a part time course of study provided for the benefit of employed persons.
 - 2.1.2 According to para 12 of A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of admissions) Order, 1974, the persons in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other Quasi Public Institutions within the State may be treated as eligible to apply for admission to the part time course of study offered by the educational Institutions in the State, subject to the control of State Government, as candidates belonging to the State of A.P.
 - 2.1.3 The other admission rules in the Presidential Order are not applicable to the admission into part time courses.
 - 2.1.4 Out of 12 seats, one seat be allocated for candidate sponsored by Private Organizations/
 Government Institutions in Andhra Pradesh State, other than Andhra Pradesh Vaidya
 Vidhana Parishad, A.P. Medical and Health Services. Such candidates shall submit
 sponsorship certificate from the competent authority of the institutions / Hospitals.
 - 2.1.5 In the selection of candidates sponsored by Private Institutions for admission into M. Sc (Nursing) course, no reservations shall be followed.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

3.1 The Candidates should be Indian National and should satisfy Local or Non-Local status as per G.O.P. 646, Education Dept., dated 10-07-1979 and must satisfy the eligibility criteria as below:

a)	Age:	Both the Service and Non-service candidates should not have completed 45 years of age as on 31 st December of the year of admission. For candidates belonging to SC and ST's the maximum age limit shall be 48 years.
b)	Sex	Both women and men candidates are eligible to apply for the M.Sc (Nursing) as per GO .Ms. No. 77, HM & FW (K1) Dept, dated 13.06.2013. Regarding male candidate, admission will be as per G.O.Ms.No.79, HM & FW (K1) Dept, dated 17.06.2013.
c)	Educational Qualification	The candidate should have passed B.Sc., (Nursing) /B.Sc., Hons (Nursing)/Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) from an Institution which is recognized by the Indian Nursing Council with minimum of 55% aggregate marks and 5% relaxation of marks for SC and ST candidates
d)	Entrance Test	Must have secured not less than 45 marks in the Entrance Test. In case of SC and ST candidates, minimum marks shall be not less than 35 marks.
e)	Registration with Nursing Council:	Candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife of Indian Nursing Council for Service and NonService candidates
f)	Experience:	
	1. For Service Candidates:	Should be a regular employee of the Government of AP / Telangana as per regulation 2.1.2 (AP Medical & Health Services and AP Vaidya Vidhan Parishad / Telangana Vaidya Vidhan Parishad) shall have put in not less than 5 years of Service of the said Dept., in any capacity in Nursing as on

31-08-2015.

2. For Regular Candidates a) (Non Service candidates):

- a) Minimum one year of work experience after Registration of B.Sc., (Nsg.,) course as on 31-08-2015
- b) Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Registration of Post Basic B.Sc., (Nsg.,) courses as on <u>31-08-2015.</u>

Note: Experience Certificate once submitted is final. No alterations/ no revised service certificate will be accepted after submission of application. The candidates who have not acquired relevant service and not submitted requisite service certificate, such applications will be rejected and no further correspondence will be entertained. Therefore candidates are advised to check the application before submitting.

g) Physical fitness

The candidate shall be medically fit.

4. **RESERVATIONS:**

- 4.1.1 15%, 6% and 29% seats are reserved for SC, ST and BC candidates respectively (A-7%, B-10%, C- 1%, D-7% and E-4%) duly following net group reservation.
- 4.1.2 In the event that if any seats reserved for S.T. not being filled up, they will be thrown open to the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and vice-versa.
- 4.1.3 In the event of the candidates from the SC and ST are not being available, these seats shall be alloted to the candidates under open competition.
- 4.1.4 If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Class of particular group are not available, the leftover seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates of General Pool.

4.2. CERTIFICATE OF CASTE:

- 4.2.1 Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish a certificate in the prescribed form appended to the application. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form the candidate shall not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.
- 4.2.2 The Social Status of the candidates who have applied for the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.Ms.No. 58, Social Welfare (J) Department, dated 12-05-1997.

4.3 RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES

4.3.1 Admission to 85% of Non-Statewide seats in each course of study (Subject / Discipline shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates inrelation to the local area. While determing 85% in favour of local candidate any fraction of a seat shall be counted as one as per the presidential order. The procedure as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) Order, 1974 as amended from time to time and the procedure indicated in Annexure-III of G.O.P. No.646 Education, dated 10-07-1979 as amended shall be followed in selecting the candidates. The remaining 15% Seats are unreserved seats.

4.4 LOCAL AREA:

- 4.4.1 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as local area in respect of the Andhra University and Nagarjuna University area for the purpose of admission.
- 4.4.2 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Adilabad, Hyderabad (including twin cities) Rangareddy, Karimnagar, Khammam, Medak, Mahaboobnagar, Nalgonda, Nizamabad and Warangal shall be regarded as local area in respect of Osmania University and Kakatiya University area for the purpose of admission.
- 4.4.3 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Ananthapur, Kurnool, Chittoor, Kadapa and Nellore shall be regarded as local area in respect of S.V. University / S.K.University area for the purpose of admission.

4.5 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

- 4.5.1 A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area
 - i) If she studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

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- ii) Where during the whole or any part of the 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, she has not studied in Educational Institutions, if she had resided in that local area for a period of not less than 4 years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared.
- 4.5.2 A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub-regulation 4.5.1 above in relation to any local area shall
 - i) If she has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than 7 consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as local candidate in relation to:
 - a) Such local area where she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.
 - b) Where the period of her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where she has last studied in such equal periods

or

- ii) If during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for relevant qualifying examination, she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but she has resided in the state during the whole of the said period of 7 years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to
- a) Such local area where she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.

or

b) Where the period of her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where she has resided last in such equal periods.

EXPLANATION: (for purpose of this sub-regulation)

- i) "Educational Institution" means a University or any Educational Institution recognized by the State Government, a University or any other competent authority.
- ii) "Relevant qualifying examination in relation to admission to any course of study" means the examination, a pass in which is the minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study.

NOTE: The relevant qualifying examination for admission to M.Sc.,(Nursing) courses is B.Sc.,(Nursing) examination. The question whether the candidate is a local candidate or not will be determined with reference to her first appearance in the Final B.Sc.,(Nursing) examination.

- iii) In reckoning the consecutive academic year during which a candidate has studied any period of interruption of her study by reasons of her failure to pass any examination and any period of her study in a statewide University or a statewide educational institution shall be disregarded.
- iv) The question whether any candidate for admission to any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of her parent or quardian.

- 4.6 While determining under sub-regulation 4.3.1 the number of seats to be reserved in favour of local candidates, any fraction of seat shall be counted as one, provided that there shall be one unreserved seat.
- 4.7 If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill any seats reserved or allocated in favour of local candidate in respect of that local area such seats shall be filled in as if it had not been reserved appeared for the Final B.Sc.,(Nursing) examination. Those who did not qualify as local candidate under sub-regulation 4.5.1 (i) or 4.5.2 (i) but claim to qualify by virtue of residence shall produce a certificate issued by an officer of the Revenue Department not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer independent charge of subtaluk/Mandal in the form annexed to G.O.P.No.628, Education, dated 25-7-1974 appended as Annexure I
- The applicant who claims to be local candidate with reference to sub-regulation 4.5.1 (i) or 4.5.2 (i) shall produce in the form of study certificate/certificates issued by the Head of the Educational Institution / Institutions concerned indicating the details of the year or years in which the candidate has studied in educational institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4/7 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first
- 4.9 The following categories are eligible to apply for admission to the 15% of unreserved seats.
 - 4.9.1 All candidates defined under Regulation 4.5.
 - 4.9.2 Candidates who have resided in the state for total period of ten years excluding period of study outside the State, or either of those parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the state.
 - 4.9.3 Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi Public Institutions in the State.
 - 4.9.4 Candidates, who are spouses of those in employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other competent authority and similar other quasi Government institutions within the State.
 - 4.9.5 Candidates who are employed in the State Government undertakings, Public Sector corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-Public institutions within the State.
 - 4.9.6 Candidates who are spouses of the local candidates as per Regulation 4.5.
 - **N.B.:** Relevant certificates must be attached to the application in respect of their claim, in respect of residence. The certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer/Tahsildar.

5. DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of the course shall be two years.

6. APPLICATIONS:

6.1 The online application form will be available on the website http://drntruhs.org from 20-07-2015, 9.00 AM to 01-08-2015 upto 5.00 p.m.

Note: The candidates are advised to take a print out of the prospectus / instructions to fill the application form from the website http://ntruhs.ap.nic.in or from http://drntruhs.org before proceeding to fill the application form.

6.2 The candidate should fill the online application form available in the Website with the data required-for, through internet. The online application form can be filled through any computer with internet connection (home/internet café/net center). The candidate is advised to fill the online application form after going through the Prospectus by keeping all the Certificates, Scanned Photo and Signature in the .jpg/.gif format separately (as shown below) (step-1) and ready to enter his/her correct data and upload the photo and signature after the payment of application fee through Online.

6.2.1 Procedure of filling online application and Procedure for online payment:

(Nursing) or equivalent Degree from out side the State of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, 10 years residence certificate of father / mother / Spouse issued by Competent Authority indicating years of residence and other relevant certificates if any in support of eligibility as per Presidential order.
- (e) All marks memos from 1st B.Sc. (Nursing) to final B.Sc. (Nursing).
- (f) Scanned Photo (80 kb in size).
- (g) Scanned Signature.
- (h) Category Certificate if applicable.
- (i) Experience / Service Certificate.
- (j) Nursing Council Registration Certificate.
- (k) Differently abled (PH) certificate if applicable.
- (I) Credit card / Debit card.

6.2.3 HOW TO SUBMIT APPLICATION

Also, You can click on application form link provided in the website and login with Application No as USER ID and Date of Birth (DD/MM/YYYY) as password(Example: 02/10/1984) to proceed for the application submission. The USER ID and password also shared through E-Mail and SMS after successful registration



6.2.4 After Logging in, candidate can view the details he filled in the previous form. To continue completing the Application form candidate needs to click on Complete Application Form button on top right corner of the screen.

On clicking of the complete application form button, the main application form will be opened for completion of all the remaining information.

All the fields marked with '*' are compulsory in the form.










6.2.7 Sample Screen Shots for uploading Photo with Signature.

- 6.2.8. Click on the choose file buttons to upload the photos from local machine. Only .jpg/.jpeg images can be uploaded which are maximum 80kb in size each.
- 6.2.9 Then click on Signature tab and similarly upload the signature from local machine. Then close the upload photo and image screen to come back to the original form.
- 6.2.10 Click next to fill the remaining information on Qualifications and Other Details tabs.





- 6.3 After completing the data entry in all pages of the online application and after submitting the data through online, the candidate should take the print-out of the filled-in online application form. The Candidate should note the Barcode application number which appears on the printout of application for future reference.
- 6.4 The candidate should paste a recent passport size photograph in the space provided in the print out of online application form. The Photo should be attested by Gezetted Officer/ Principal of the College (identical to the photo that used for scanning)

6.5 Registration Fee:

The registration fee is Rs. 3,000/- (Bank transaction charges extra) for OC/BC categories and Rs.2,700/- (Bank transaction charges extra) for SC/ST categories.

Verification Fee: The candidates who acquired their Under Graduate Degree outside the State or Country/Abroad and got their certificates registered with Nursing Council of India and applying for Entrance Test for admission into M.Sc. Nursing courses under this University, shall pay a verification fee of Rs.5,000/- for degree certificates acquired Abroad and Rs.1,000/- for the degrees acquired outside the State.

- 6.6 The candidate <u>should sign at the declaration</u> area in the print out of the online application form and also put left hand thumb impression at the space provided without fail.
- 6.7 LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF PRINTOUT OF FILLED-IN ONLINE APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION ALONG WITH ENCLOSOURES IS <u>05-08-2015</u> (Wednesday) at 5.00 P.M.
- 6.7.1 The candidate should submit the print-out of the filled-in online application alongwith the attested copies of required certificates to <u>The Convener, PG Admissions Committee, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, A.P. Vijayawada 8</u> either by post or in person on or before <u>5.00 PM on 05-08-2015</u>. The candidate shall clearly
 - superscribe on the cover name of the course applied for "Dr.NTRUHS M.Sc.(Nursing) ET-2015".
- 6.7.2 Application forms received without copies of the required certificates, incomplete applications, without signing declaration, applications received after last date and time, will stand automatically rejected. Postal delay or loss in transit will not be condoned. Application forms of ineligible candidates will be summarily rejected.

- Note: 1)The candidature of the applicant will not be considered for M.Sc.(Nursing)ET-2015 unless the printout application form is submitted to the University alongwith the requisite enclosures on or before the cutoff date. The University holds no responsibility for postal delays / Loss in Transit.
 - 2) The Entrance test committee is taking every precaution to grant eligibility to all the eligible candidates who have fulfilled all Statutory Regulations to appear for M.Sc. (Nursing) ET 2015 and registered by enclosing all the documents including payment of fee. 8. ENTRANCE TEST:

- 8.1 Computer Based (Online) Entrance Test will be conducted for admission into the M.Sc. (Nursing) Courses.
- 8.2 The Entrance Test will be conducted on 16-08-2015 from 10.00 AM to 11.30 AM at three centres i.e., Hyderabad, Vijayawada & Visakhapatnam.
- 8.3 Entrance Test shall consist of 100 multiple choice questions and the syllabus for the Entrance Test shall be that of B.Sc. (Nursing) standard of Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences.
- 8.4 The duration of Examination is 90 minutes.
- 8.5 All the questions will be of one best / correct response type having four alternatives.
- 8.5.1 Each answer with correct response shall be awarded one mark.
- 8.5.2 There is no negative mark for incorrect response.
- 8.5.3 Zero mark will be given for the questions not answered.
- 8.5.4 Choose the most appropriate answer.
- 8.5.5 All eligible candidates shall appear for Entrance Test. Only the candidates who qualify in the entrance test are eligible for admission
- 8.5.6 The merit list for the qualified candidates shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance test subject to regulation-10.
- 8.5.7 Minimum marks required to qualify in the entrance test shall be as per regulation 3(d).
- 8.5.8 The answer key will be released and objections if any should be sent to the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada by e-mail uhsetss@gmail.com in the prescribed proforma vide annexure–VI* of the regulations before the date and time specified.






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Instructions Screen:

8.6.1 ENTRANCE TEST – GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS – DO'S AND DON'T'S

- 8.6.2 Candidate should report at the test venue one hour before the start of the test. No entry will be permitted after 09.30 AM. i.e., commencement of Examination process.
- 8.6.3 Candidates taking the Entrance Examination will be subjected to thorough frisking before being allowed into the hall at the stipulated time.
- 8.6.4 Biometric finger print and image capture will be done for every candidate on the day of Examination inside the Examination hall by the authorized personnel.
- 8.6.5 Carry only Hallticket and original ID inside the hall. No candidate will be allowed to take the examination without producing the valid Hallticket and photo ID. The candidate has to submit a copy of Hallticket and photo ID to the invigilator. Therefore candidates are advised to attend with copies of Hallticket and photo ID.
- 8.6.6 The Examination will be Computer Based (Online) Test. Check the seating plan and identify the room/lab allotted as per his/her hall ticket number.
- 8.6.7 Candidates are not allowed to carry any Text materials, Printed or Written, bits of papers, envelope or any other materials except the Hall Ticket and Photo ID inside the Examination Hall.
- 8.6.8 Pens, Pencils, Calculators, Electronic Digital Watches, Cellular phones, Pagers or any other Electronic gadgets are not allowed inside the examination hall.

9 UNFAIR MEANS IN THE ENTRANCE TEST:

- 9.1.1. Hall Ticket is not transferable. Hall Ticket should not be tampered.
- 9.1.2. A person should not Impersonate a candidate.
- 9.1.3. Except Hall Ticket & Photo ID, candidate should not possess any Pen, Pencil, Papers, Books or Notes or Written notes or any type of Electronic gadgets like Pagers, Cell Phones, Computers, Calculators, Bluetooth etc., on his clothes, body or table or chair, in to the examination Hall / Centres.
- 9.1.4. Candidate should not talk to another candidate or person inside or outside the examination hall without permission of the invigilating staff.
- 9.1.5. Candidate should not show his / her Monitor to another candidate or he / she should not receive, attempt to receive help from any source, including consulting books, notes or papers or any other matter outside the exam hall or has given help or attempted to give help.
- 9.1.6. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before completion of 1½ hour after commencement of the examination.
- 9.1.7. On completion of answering the questions, he / she should seek permission of the invigilator and leave the hall, only after handing over copy of Hall Ticket and Photo ID to the invigilator.

9.2 Violation of any one or all of the above instructions will be considered as malpractice.

- 9.2.1. Any candidate resorting to malpractice in the Entrance Examination will have his / her examination invalidated and will be disqualified from appearing for PG Entrance Examination for the next 3 years.
- 9.2.2. If a person impersonates a candidate, he / she will be disqualified from appearing for any Entrance examination for five years and if he/she is not on university rolls, will not be admitted to any course for five years and the criminal case will be lodged against him/her in the police station, the candidate who is impersonated also will be disqualified for 5 years.

10. BASIS FOR PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST:

10.1.1 The criteria for preparation of merit list of candidates shall be as follows:

Criteria ranking:

1st Criteria Marks obtained at the Entrance Test

2nd Criteria Total percentage of marks obtained in B.Sc., (Nursing) course upto 2

decimal places

3rd Criteria Age

Note: If the candidate fails to submit all the marks lists from 1st to final year B.Sc., (Nursing), the minimum passing marks shall be taken into consideration.

10.1.2 In case of equality of ranks after application of first ranking criteria, the second ranking criteria shall be applied. In case of persisting equality of ranks, the 3rd ranking criteria shall be adopted.

10.2 ENTRANCE TEST RESULTS:

The list of provisionally successful candidates along with their marks, categories and ranks shall be notified in press and at the colleges and Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences Office, Vijayawada.

11. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION:

Master merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained at the entrance test and selections shall be made subject to the procedure of reservation prescribed in the regulations.

12.1 COUNSELING PROCEDURE:

- 12.1.1 The University shall constitute a Selection Committee.
- 12.1.2 The selections will be held at Office of the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada as notified by the University.
- 12.1.3 The selection will be done course wise.
- 12.1.4 All the Qualified candidates at the M.Sc., (Nursing) Entrance Test 2015-16 may attend the counseling
- 12.1.5 The Selection Committee shall provisionally select the candidates as per these regulations from among the candidates who qualified in the entrance test and as per merit list.
- 12.1.6 The candidates shall submit their option for subjects of their choice in order of priority to the Selection Committee. The selection committee will select the candidates as per the Admission Regulations and Government Rules from among the candidates who physically present themselves and submitted their options. The list of provisionally selected candidates will be displayed and the provisional selection intimations will be issued to the selected candidates. The selection will be made only from among the candidates who physically present themselves when their hall ticket numbers are called out in order of merit.
- 12.1.7 Claims of the candidates will not be considered if they are absent when called at the time of selection. If a candidate on merit is absent for selection when she is called, then next in the merit would be selected. The selected candidates shall submit their original certificates to the selection committee.
- 12.1.8 The candidates shall be called to appear before the Selection Committee one after another and they shall not enter the selection committee room in groups. Any person who obstructs the proceedings of the Selection Committee or otherwise misbehaves or causes disturbance at the selection committee meeting will be liable for disciplinary action as may be taken by the University.
- 12.1.9 The Selection Committee shall have power to review the provisional selection in case of any errors, misrepresentation, fraud or glaring injustice. In all matters relating to selections and admissions the decision of the selection committee shall be final and binding on the candidates and selections cannot be questioned after admissions are closed.
- 12.1.10 If a candidate after choosing the subject fails to pay fees or after paying the fees fails to submit the bond her selection stands cancelled automatically. If a candidate is absent at the first selection, she will be considered for selection at the subsequent selection in the available courses.

- 12.1.11 Vacancies will be filled by the selection Committee on the dates as per schedule.
- 12.1.12 After first selections if any vacancies ,will be open to all the candidates with merit order below the merit order of the candidate who vacated the seat for that speciality, in that area and also candidate who were absent in the earlier selection.
- 12.1.13 The provisional selection shall be subject to the condition that the candidates satisfy the Principal about the correctness of certificates given in the application form and also about the eligibility.

13. POWERS OF NURSING SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- 13.1 The whole process of admission of candidates into M. Sc., (Nursing) courses shall be made under the general supervision and guidance of the Nursing Selection Committee, constituted by the University.
- 13.2 The Nursing Selection Committee shall select candidates in accordance with the provisions of these regulations. The committee is empowered to take such steps as it considers necessary for early completion of the selection.
- 13.3 The Selection committee shall have power to review its decision and either admit or cancel the admission.

14. VACANCIES:

Vacancies if any caused due to failure to join or cancellation of admission or demise of the candidate etc., before the closure of admissions shall be filled by the Admission Committee in accordance with the regulations.

15. JOINING TIME:

The selected candidates shall join the institution concerned within the specified date alongwith the original certificates and documents required. No request shall be entertained for extension of time under any circumstances. Failure to join the course in time shall automatically result in cancellation of the seat.

16. CLOSURE OF ADMISSIONS:

Admissions shall be closed as per the Indian Nursing Council Regulations.

17. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS:

- 17.1 The Principal of the respective Nursing College shall verify the authenticity of the documents. If satisfied shall direct the candidate to pay the fees etc., immediately.
- 17.2 All Original documents and declarations shall be preserved in the safe custody of the Principal of the respective Nursing colleges in order to facilitate any enquiry in future.

18. FEES:

18.1 **TUITION FEE:** All the candidates selected are required to pay the <u>tuition fee as</u> prescribed by the Government from time to time.

In respect of Private Nursing colleges the tuition fee is as given below as per G.O.Ms.No.405 HM & FW (K2) Dept., dt.25-11-2008 and as amended from time to time.

Other constituent fee, special fee and caution money deposits etc., have to pay at the admission at college as per the respective college rules.

18.2 All the selected candidates shall pay the following fee in the form of crossed demand draft drawn on ANY NATIONALISED BANK in favour of Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences payable at Vijayawada alongwith the bond. The fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

18.3 As per the University Notification vide 5280/A8/Acad/12 dt.18-5-2014, it is hereby notified that the students who acquired their UG Degree at outside the state or abroad, got their certificates registered by the concerned statutory bodies like, MCI, DCI, INC, CCIM, CCH etc., and seeking admission into PG courses notified by this University, shall pay a weification fee (Rs.5,000/- for degree certificates acquired abroad and Rs.1,000.- for the degrees acquired outside the state) while applying for admission to any PG courses as per the admission notification issued by Dr. NTRUHS, Vijayawada.

19. POWERS OF THE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION:

- 19.1 Not withstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Head of the Institution may, at any time either suomoto or on an application made by any person, after due and proper enquiry, if she is satisfied that the candidate has furnished incorrect information or enclosed false certificates or fraudulently obtained admission, may, for the reasons to be recorded in writing, by order, cancel her admission, provided that no such admission shall be cancelled without giving a reasonable opportunity for showing cause as to why her admission should not be cancelled.
- 19.2 Against any such order of the Head of the Institution an appeal shall be with the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences.

20. POWERS OF THE Dr. NTR UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES:

The Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences may either suo-moto or on application made to them call for to examine the records relating to any selection or admission or cancellation thereof, made by the concerned authority for the purpose of satisfying themselves as to the correctness, regularity or propriety of such order in relation thereto as they deem fit, including cancellation of the selection already published or admission already made provided that the University may, before cancelling such selection or admission give an opportunity to the authority and to the person effected to show-cause against such cancellation.

21. FINALITY OF SELECTION:

All selections made under these rules shall be subject to any general rules or orders that may be made by the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences/ Government from time to time.

22. DEPUTATION:

Regular inservice candidates of Andhra Pradesh / Telangana Medical and Health Services shall be on deputation.

23. BOND TO SERVE THE EMPLOYER/GOVERNMENT:

All inservice candidates of Medical & Health Dept., on admission have to execute a bond on a nonjudicial stamp paper worth of Rs.100/- (Rupees hundred only) embodying the conditions of training and agreeing to serve the Employer/State Government for a period of atleast 5 years on successful completion of the course, in any capacity as the Government may consider suitable and in default they shall be Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakhs only) besides refund of the amount received as salary upto the date to the Government as prescribed in Annexure - III.

24. BOARDING AND LODGING:

- 24.1 All should adhere to the institutional rules and violation of rules will be viewed seriously.
- 24.2 The candidates have to pay the fees towards their food if they reside in the hostel alongwith other fees as prescribed from time to time.
- 25. Break of study and re-admission: If a student absents continuously for a period of 91 days or more and seeks permission to attend the course, his / her application in prescribed format by paying requisite fee in favour of Registrar, Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences payable at Vijayawada shall be forwarded to the Registrar, Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences with the recommendation of the Principal. Regulations for readmission after break of study alongwith application format and fee payable is available in the university website. The candidates are advised to refer the regulations before submitting the application and paying the fee. If they fulfilled the regulatory conditions, they may submit applications through the Principal of the College by paying the fee.

25.1 AGREEMENT BOND:

All the candidates joining the M.Sc (Nursing) course shall execute a bond on nonjudicial stamp paper of value of Rs100/- as prescribed in Annexure II to the regulations to ensure completion of the prescribed period of study or in default to pay Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) by remitting the amount in favour of the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada payable at Vijayawada and submit the receipt to the Principal of the respective Nursing College and the Principal shall relieve the candidate.

26. LEAVE:

Each year students will be permitted to avail 30 days leave. No Post Graduate is allowed to go on leave more than 8 days at a stretch. Incase the absence of the candidate availing Medical Leave / Maternity Leave / Any other Leave or unauthorized absence is beyond 30 days in a year the study period of the candidate will be extended to the extent of such period. No other leave is permitted.

27. UNIFORM:

All the candidates are expected to wear the Uniform on duty prescribed by the respective College

28. COURSE OF STUDY:

The candidates admitted into M. Sc (Nursing) course shall pursue the study in accordance with the syllabus prescribed by the Academic Senate of Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences.

29. EXAMINATIONS:

The candidates shall have to appear for such examinations as prescribed by the University from time to time.

ANTI RAGGING ACT

Ragging is prohibited in the Educational Institutions in the state of AP vide Act No.26 of 1997, dt. 21-8-1997. The Anti raging Act is placed on the Website of the University for information.
