NOTIFICATION

Vide the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board Act, 2014, the State Govt. in the Higher Education Deptt. has conferred the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board (WBJEEB) the status of a Statutory Body. Subject to the provisions of this Act, the WBJEEB shall have to conduct counselling and admission process in respect of Master of Computer (MCA) course in the academic session 2015-16”.

And whereas for admission into the MCA programme, it is essential for the candidates to have appeared in the State Common Entrance Examination i.e JECA – 2015 and to secure a rank, it has been decided by the State Government in the Higher Education Department to continue the admission process on the basis of the norms of the AICTE and other regulatory authorities, the following guidelines and instruction for counselling and admission in the Master of Computer Application (MCA) course for academic session 2015-16 are provided hereunder

Guidelines

1. Venue of Counselling :

VIVEKANANDA YUBA BHARATI KRIRANGAN (SALT LAKE STADIUM),
SALT LAKE, KOLKATA-700098

2. Period of Counselling :

11th -12th August 2015

3. Application Form and E-Challan :

Application Form submitted for JECA 2015, Rank Card and e-challan can be down loaded from appropriate links in Board’s website : www.wbjeeb.in from Saturday, August 8th, 2015. Candidates should bring the duly filled in forms (as stated above) with them on the day of counselling.

4. Counselling Fee :

Candidates have to pay a non-refundable Counselling fee for **Rs. 506/-** through the duly filled-in e-challan at the **Allahabad Bank counter** to be opened at **counselling venue- VIVEKANANDA YUBA BHARATI KRIRANGAN (SALT LAKE STADIUM)** on the days of Counselling.

5. Eligibility Criteria :

(A) Following minimum qualification to JECA-2015 qualified for the academic session 2015-16 :

All Universities, Govt. College and Self-financed Private Colleges that offer the three years Master of Computer Application (MCA) course in the State of West Bengal shall follow one of the four modules regarding eligibility criteria for admission of JECA-2015 qualified candidates in the said course for the 2015-16 academic session.

The four modules are:

Module 1: Candidate must have passed 3-years Bachelor degree program from UGC recognized University with at least 60% in Honours/Aggregate (45% for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) or AICTE recognized BCA of a University/Institute along with 60% marks in Mathematics at the Bachelor's level.

Candidates have to secure at least 60% marks in Secondary and Higher Secondary or equivalent level from recognized Boards with at least 60% marks in Mathematics at each level.

Module 2: UGC and/or AICTE recognized (as the case may be) Bachelor's degree of minimum 3-years duration except BBA with Mathematics at 10+2 level or graduate level.
Obtained 50% marks (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) at graduation level.

Module 3: Graduate or equivalent degree under (10+2+3) pattern in any discipline of a UGC recognized University/Institute or AICTE recognized B.E./B.Tech/BCA of a University/Institute. Candidate must have Mathematics as one of the subjects at each level of education. Candidates have to secure 60% marks (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) at each level education.

Module 4: B.Sc. Honours degree under (10+2+3) pattern in any discipline of a UGC recognized University/Institute with at least 60% marks in Hons./Aggregate (45% marks for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates) along with at least 55% marks in Mathematics. Candidate have to secure at least 60% marks in Secondary and Higher Secondary or equivalent level from recognized Boards with at least 60% marks in Mathematics at each level.

NB : Validity of Degree certificate under Territorial Jurisdiction of the State Universities / State Private Universities

The WBJEEB will not allow any candidate holding the degree certificate from state universities where he/she studied through off campus centre(s) outside the territorial jurisdiction of the state.

4. Reservation Policy

4.1 Availability of seats for SC / ST Category:

Reservation of seats for SC / ST candidates domiciled in West Bengal shall be made as per the State Govt. Rules, in respect of all Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges as well as State-aided Universities / University Departments following the Gazette Notification vide the West Bengal Act X of 2013, dated, 30th April, 2013 followed by the Rules vide Notification no. 07-Edn (U), dated, the 2nd January, 2014 published in the Kolkata Gazette vide Registered no. WB/SC-247, dated, 3rd January, 2014. For Self-Financing Engineering & Technology/ Pharmacy Institutions, reservation of seats for such students is not mandatory. However, seats may be made available by willing Institutions, and this would be reflected in the Seat Matrix provided in the website for counselling.

4.2 Availability of seats for PwD (Persons with Disabilities) Category Students:

Reservation of seats for PwD candidates domiciled in West Bengal shall be made as per the State Govt. norms for all Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges as well as State-aided Universities/University Departments following the Gazette Notification vide no. 65-Edn (U), dated 16.01.2014 i.e. persons with Disabilities will enjoy a 3% reservation in each of the categories i.e. SC, ST, OBC-A and OBCB category of seats as well as in the Unreserved Category of seats. For Self Financing Engineering & Technology/Pharmacy Institutes, reservation of seats for such students is not mandatory. However, seats may be made available by willing Institutions, and this would be reflected in the Seat Matrix of JECA-2015 provided in the website for counselling.

4.3 Availability of seats for OBC-A and OBC-B Category students:

As per the Gazette Notification, vide the West Bengal Act X of 2013, dated, 30th April, 2013 followed by the Rules vide Notification no. 07-Edn (U), dated, 2nd January, 2014 published in the Kolkata Gazette vide Registered no. WB/SC-247, dated, 3rd January, 2014, reservation of seats for such categories of students is applicable for Govt. Engineering & Technology Colleges and State-Aided Universities/University Departments subject to certain pre-conditions such as prior approval of regulatory authorities, creation/availability of infrastructure etc. In the academic session of 2015-16, availability of seats for OBC -A category and OBC-B category would be reflected in the

Seat Matrix provided in the website for counselling. For Self-Financing Engineering & Technology/Pharmacy Institutes, reservation of seats for such students is not mandatory. However, seats may be made available by willing Institutions, which would be reflected in the Seat Matrix for JECA-2015 provided in the website for counselling.

Note: For the categories under 4.1, 4.2 and 4.3, marks of the qualifying examinations will be 5% less than the General Category of Students.

5. For admission to MCA course under PWD category :

The PWD candidates claiming seats under reserved category are required to satisfy the following criteria.

For PWD (loco motor disorder, visual impairment, speech and hearing impairment) category candidate a minimum of 40% disability is required subject to the condition that the candidate is capable of carrying out all activities related to theory and practical work as applicable to MCA course without any special concession and exemption.

6. Important documents to be brought positively by the candidates during counselling :

- a) Filled in and already submitted Application Form for JECA-2015 (to be downloaded).
- b) Bank challan. (Counselling fees of Rs. 506 /- to be deposited through downloadable e-challan in the Bank counter at counselling venue)
- c) Down loaded Rank card of JECA-2015
- d) Original mark sheet of Madhyamik or equivalent examination.
- e) Original mark sheet of Higher secondary or equivalent examination.
- f) Original graduate level mark sheets under (10+2+3) pattern (both pass and honours) as applicable.
- g) Any other document in original required for satisfying eligibility and other criteria of different Universities / Institutes.
- h) In case of SC/ST/PWS/OBC-A/OBC-B, Certificates issued from the Competent Authority for verification.

7. Procedure to be followed in case of candidates unable to appear in the counselling in person owing to valid reason :

If any candidate is unable to appear in the counselling in person owing to valid reasons under exceptional circumstances / medical ground, his/her parent/guardian may be permitted to appear in the counselling on his/her behalf with the following documents.

- a) Authorization letter by the candidate attesting the photo and signature of his/her parent/guardian and also declaring in the said authorization letter that he/she would not claim any seat in the Institution other than the one allotted to him/her through his/her representative by authorization.
- b) Medical Certificate from a registered practitioner :
- c) All original testimonials as mentioned under Sl. No (5) above under heading “Important documents to be brought positively by the candidates during counselling”

8. Other pertinent points to be noted :

- a) Candidates are required to be present positively half an hour before from the specified time slot for their Counselling in the Counselling Programme.
- b) Candidates should note that allotment of a seat in any University/ Institute by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board is entirely provisional and is subject to fulfilment of the eligibility and other criteria specific to the allotted University / Institute for admission to Master of Computer Application course. If the candidate does not possess the said eligibility criteria his allotment would be cancelled outright at the moment of detection at any level.
Such eligibility and other criteria would have to be verified by the concerned University / Institute where the candidate has been allotted by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board at the time of admission.
- c) **Candidates belonging to states other than West Bengal shall not be considered for admission to Govt. Engineering colleges.**
- d) **Reservation of seats for SC / ST / PWD / OBC-A / OBC-B is applicable to the candidates of the State of West Bengal only. SC / ST / PWD / OBC-A / OBC-B candidates of other States can not avail of this facility.**
- e) For Government and Govt. aided Engineering & Technological Colleges the reservation of seats for SC / ST / PWD / OBC-A / OBC-B candidates will be as per Government Rules. For Universities / University Departments reservation rules in case of SC / ST / PWD / OBC-A / OBC-B candidates of the concerned Universities shall be followed.
- f) Appearance of a rank in the counselling schedule does not guarantee a seat in any University / Institute . Counselling for allotment of seats will be stopped as soon as the last vacant seat is filled up and no further queries in this regard will be entertained.
- g) The claim of a candidate to exercise option shall be limited to the vacancies prevalent at that instant when his / her turn comes for appearing before the counselling officials.
- h) Only one option will have to be exercised at the time of counselling. Once the allotment of a seat in any University / Institute is done no further change of the University / Institute will be entertained.

- i) A candidate failing to appear before the counselling officials at the allotment counter on the schedule date and time in order of his / her position in the list owing to delay on his / her part may be allowed to appear before the counselling officials after verifying the testimonials regarding eligibility criteria for consideration for allotment of seat in any University / Institute available at that instant only irrespective of his / her rank.
- j) No refund of counselling fee is admissible.
- k) Modification of the counselling schedule may be brought about under exigent circumstances.
- l) Candidates will be required to take admission to the allotted University / Institute within five days from the date of allotment.

9. Any candidate appearing at the counselling with fake documents/testimonials will be handed over to the police instantly.

10. Any other important information related to the aforesaid counselling (if any) will be immediately communicated through the websites mentioned in Sl. No. 3.
