Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya invites applications for admission to programmes leading to Doctor of Philosophy Degree (herein after referred to as the Ph. D. Degree) in various disciplines as given in Section - A, Table-1. Admissions shall be done as per University PhD Regulation 2009 and as decided by the Academic Council of the University from time to time in accordance with the UGC minimum qualification for M.Phil. / PhD regulation 2009. The admission to the said programme shall be (a) through the Vishwavidyalaya Research Entrance Test (VRET) to be conducted at Bilaspur (University Campus) on 24th May 2015 (Sunday) and (b) directly under the VRET exempted categories (as detailed in Section-H of this information bulletin).

Note:- Admission to PhD program shall be subjected to the availability of seats and supervisor. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill any seat and also to alter the nature and number of seats if the circumstances so warrant.

NET (JRF) NET (LS) and GATE qualified M.E/M-Tech applicants (For Engineering & Technology) and other categories of applicants listed in Section H shall be eligible for direct admission. However, if applicants belonging to NET (LS)/GATE qualified M.Tech (For Engineering & Technology) wish to be considered for GGV research fellowship, they will have to appear in VRET and be admitted as VRET applicant.

B. MAIN DISCIPLINE – ALLIED DISCIPLINE COMBINATIONS

To provide an opportunity for inter-disciplinary research, applicants are given option to fill the preference of maximum two allied disciplines in addition to the main discipline in which he/she will appear for VRET examination. Such applicants may be considered for admission in allied discipline (subject to the availability of seats) under the following norms.

- I. An applicant shall appear in the VRET of the discipline in which he/she has done his/her Post Graduate Course.
- II. In order to promote inter disciplinary research, an applicant is provided option of working in allied discipline (as given for each main discipline in Section B, Table-2) in which VRET is being conducted. However, all such applicants will appear in VRET in the main discipline only.
- III. The option of allied discipline is not mandatory; those applicants who wish to be considered only in main discipline need not give option of allied discipline.
- IV. Further, all such applicants who have opted for allied discipline and admitted in the same shall be awarded degree in main discipline only.
- V. Also that one of the research supervisors shall be from main discipline. In addition, one co-supervisor can be chosen from allied discipline.
- VI. The admission in allied discipline is subject to availability of seats in the allied discipline and opting for allied discipline does not guarantee the admission in that discipline.

VII. Further, in any discipline, the maximum number of admissions that can be given to applicants from allied discipline shall be maximum 30% of the vacancies in the main discipline. However, if in any discipline, the seats are not filled up due to lack of applicants from the main discipline, students from the allied discipline may be admitted.

VIII. The list of allied disciplines corresponding to a main discipline in which the applicant is eligible for admission by virtue of appearing in the VRET of the main discipline is listed below:

If the applicant possesses PG degree in a discipline listed in column (3) of table-2, titled as "Allied Discipline", and VRET is not being conducted in the discipline of his PG degree, then he/she shall opt for the corresponding main discipline in which VRET shall be held. Accordingly, he/ she shall be eligible to be considered for admission to the corresponding main discipline and such other allied disciplines to the main discipline (in which he/she appears for the VRET) is an allied discipline (as detailed at Section B of this Information Bulletin).

ALLIED SUBJECTS:

Applicants having P.G. degree in subjects in which VRET is not being conducted. However, the subject is considered as an allied subject for one of the subjects in which VRET is being conducted. List of allied subjects is given in Table-2. Such applicants having degree in allied subject may seek admission by appearing in the VRET of related main discipline. The details of admission for such applicants are as given below:

- IX. In such cases, where VRET is not conducted in the applicant's discipline at PG level but the said discipline is an "Allied Subject" to one of the main disciplines in which VRET is conducted, he/she shall appear in the VRET for the said main discipline.
- X. Further, in such cases, where VRET is not conducted in the applicant's discipline at PG level and the said discipline is an allied subject to more than one main disciplines in which VRET is conducted, he/she may opt for VRET in a discipline which is more relevant to his/her P.G. discipline in his/her opinion..

Note:

- i) The applicants who wish to be considered for main discipline and allied disciplines in addition to main disciplines to the maximum of three (03) choices in the Application Form. The choice of discipline once indicated in the Application Form shall be final and shall not be changed subsequently on any ground. (There can be less than 2 allied disciplines to a main discipline in which case choice will be limited to given allied disciplines only). However, filling of allied discipline is optional and such applicants will be considered and if seats are availability in the allied discipline.
- ii) Subject to an applicant qualifying in the main discipline and/or its allied disciplines, he/she can appear in the counseling/interview for admissions in such departments as per the schedule notified in the results.

- iii) For being eligible to apply for VRET, an applicant must satisfy himself/herself that he/she satisfies the prescribed minimum eligibility requirements (Section 'C').
- iv) An applicant can appear in VRET of only one discipline as VRET will be held on same date and time for all the disciplines.
- v) In case of operational difficulty, any of the disciplines for VRET may be withdrawn at any stage.

C. QUALIFYING EXAMINATION AND MINIMUM PERCENTAGE OF MARKS:

An applicant shall be required to have passed the qualifying examination securing the minimum percentage of marks at the time of applying for VRET as per details given below:

Details of Qualifying Examinations:

Note: Any degree mentioned under the qualifying examination for each school of studies in the following pertains to the degree awarded by this University or any other University established by law for the time being in force or any other degree recognized as equivalent thereto in that subject.

I. Schools of Arts, Social Sciences*, Physical Science, Life Science, Mathematical & Computational Science and Natural Resources

- (a) **Qualifying Examination:** (i) Master's degree in the concerned subject **OR** (ii) Masters degree in any one of the allied subjects pertaining to the discipline as per the list given in the Section - B.
- (b) **Qualifying Marks:** At least 55% in the aggregate or equivalent grade point average in the qualifying examination.

II. School of Management and Commerce

(a) Qualifying Examination:

Master's degree in Commerce (M.Com.)

Master's degree in Business Management (M.B.M.), Management Studies/ Management Sciences (M.M.S.), Business Administration (M.B.A.), International Business, Administration (M.I.B.A.), International Business (M.I.B.) **OR** Two years postgraduate diploma in Management from any one of the Indian Institutes of Management (I.I.Ms) or Xavier Labour Relations Institute (X.L.R.I.), Jamshedpur or Management Development Institute (M.D.I.), Gurgaon or Institute of Management and Technology (I.M.T.), Ghaziabad or Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (I.I.F.T.), New Delhi or International Management Institute (I.M.I.), New Delhi.

Qualifying Marks: At least 55% marks in the aggregate or equivalent grade point average in the qualifying examination.

*** For the Department of Education in the School of Social Science:**

- (a) **Qualifying Examination:** M.Ed./M.A. (Education)/ Master's degree in Special Education [M.Ed. (Spl.)] **OR** Master's degree in Psychology/ Sociology/ Economics.
- (b) **Qualifying Marks:** At least 55% in aggregate or equivalent grade point average in the qualifying examination.

III. Engineering & Technology

GATE qualified M.E/M. Tech with minimum 60% of marks.

- (a-1) RELAXATION IN MINIMUM PERCENTAGE OF MARKS FOR Scheduled Castes (SC)/Scheduled Tribes (ST) / Physically Challenged (PC) APPLICANTS:** There shall be a relaxation of 5% marks (or equivalent grade point average) for SC/ST and PC applicants in the minimum marks required in the qualifying examination. Physically Challenged (PC), SC/ST applicant shall not get the double benefit of being SC/ST as well as PC applicant in the above relaxations.

Note:

- (i) Any applicant appearing in VRET for seeking admission in PhD program offered by this university must have passed the qualifying examination at the time of admission. **Applicants appearing in the qualifying examination may also apply.**
- (a) Where the Grade Sheet does not mention the equivalent percentage of marks from grade points, the applicant should submit such a certificate of conversion from the concerned Institution mentioning either the converted percentage, or the formula for the actual conversion of grade point average to percentage of marks.
- (b) Where the Grade Sheet itself mentions the equivalent percentage of marks from grade points, or the formula for such conversion, the applicant should get both sides of the Degree/Grade Sheet photocopied showing the equivalent percentage of marks/conversion formula and enclose with the Application Form.
- (c) In case there is no conversion formula for computing the percentage, CGPA (out of 10) multiplied by 10 will constitute the percentage. If the CGPA is available out of 4, then CGPA multiplied by 25 will constitute the percentage.
- (ii) "Aggregate percentage of marks" does not include grace marks awarded to an applicant.
- (iii) An applicant already possessing a Ph. D. degree of this or any other University shall be eligible to be admitted to the Ph. D. programme for an additional Ph. D. degree in a subject other than the subject in which he/she already possesses the Ph. D. Degree. The admission of such a applicant will be at the discretion of the Vice-Chancellor, who, on the basis of specific recommendation and full justification by the Departmental/School Research Committee (DRC/SRC) after considering certain relevant criteria such as, the synopsis of the proposed topic, relevance of the proposed topic and its relationship with the topic of the first Ph. D., etc. will take a final decision.
- (iv) **Applicants must satisfy himself/herself about fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements as prescribed above before filling the online / offline Application Form.**

D. RESERVATIONS:

Reservations for SC/ST and OBC applicants will be provided as per government of India rules.

Further, 3% horizontal reservation for Physically Challenged (PC) applicants [Visually Impaired (1%) + Hearing Impaired (1%) + Orthopedically Handicapped (1%)] shall be provided. The PC applicants will have to submit a Disability certificate issued by the District CMO with the Application Form. Applicants eligible for counseling will be examined by a Medical Board constituted by GGV and if necessary, will be referred by the Medical Board to other recognized bodies for the purpose, as per criteria fixed by the University.

'Writer' for Blind Applicants: 'Writer' will be provided by the University to each blind applicant. The qualifications of 'writers' shall be decided by the University. Such a applicant is required to apply for 'writer' to the Deputy Registrar (Academic) on the prescribed application form for the purpose *at least 15 days prior to the date of VRET*. For this purpose, the applicant has to collect the form from the Office of the Deputy Registrar (Academic), and submit the same affixing a passport size photograph identical to that affixed on the application form.

N.B. for 'Physically Challenged' Applicants: In certain Courses/Departments/Faculties (like Dept. of Physical Education); admission of Physically Challenged applicants is not permissible. Details may be sought from the Deputy Registrar (Academic).

If Physically Challenged applicant is not available, the seat may be transferred to the applicants of general category. The number of seats reserved for SC/ST/PC/OBC categories shall be reduced proportionately if number of qualified applicants is less. The vacant seats reserved for SC/ST applicants, if any, shall be filled as per Government of India rules.

Each SC/ST/OBC applicant shall have to submit a copy of the certificate mentioning that the applicant belongs to SC/ST/OBC community. Such certificates shall be subject to verification from the concerned District Magistrate. The following are empowered to issue the certificate:

- (a) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/ Addl. Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/City Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- (b) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Addl. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate.
- (c) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- (d) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the applicant and/or his family normally resides.
- (e) Administrator/Secretary to the Administrator/ Development Officer (Lakshadweep Islands).

Applicants must note that the certificate from any other person/authority shall not be accepted in any case.

Further, 'General category' includes all applicants other than those belonging to SC, ST or OBC. If the applicant happens to belong to SC, ST or OBC, his/her caste/tribe must be listed in the appropriate Govt. of India schedule. The caste certificate should be in the Govt. approved format and should clearly state: (a) Name of his/her caste/tribe (b) whether he/she belongs to SC/ST/OBC (c) District and the State or Union Territory of his/her ordinary residence and (d) the appropriate Govt. of India schedule under which his/her caste/tribe is approved by it as SC, ST or OBC. Further, the OBC Certificate should clearly mention that the applicant is not under creamy layer.

However, if a student seeks admission under some other category the applicant should satisfy the minimum eligibility requirement for that category.

E. DISCIPLINE NAME & DISCIPLINE CODE NUMBER:

The applicants will be required to write the preferences for disciplines along with code numbers on the 'Application Form'. The details about this are given below:

F. NOTES:

- I. Notwithstanding anything contained in the relevant Ordinances, the eligibility requirements for the purpose of admission shall be only those which are mentioned in the Information Bulletin of the academic session concerned.
- II. All Ph. D. Scholars shall be governed by the Ph. D. Ordinance/Regulations of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya as modified from time to time.
- III. The applicant shall be bound by GGU Statutes/Ordinances/Rules and Regulations framed from time to time.

G. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- (i) An applicant who satisfies the requirements mentioned in Section C should apply on the prescribed Application Form for **VRET/VRET (Exempted)**. The application can be submitted online/ offline.
- (ii) Application Forms of applicants who have submitted forged/fake certificates or adopted fraudulent means shall be **REJECTED** without any intimation to the applicants. Further, such applicants shall be debarred from appearing in any subsequent Entrance Tests conducted by GGV.
- (iii) Applicants are allowed to appear at the VRET provisionally subject to the final verification of Mark sheets/Degrees/certificates, validity of certificates/Mark sheets of Qualifying

Examination and also of involvement in the adoption of unfair means in any of the University Examination/Entrance Tests held earlier, at the time of admission. Degrees/certificates recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) shall only be deemed as equivalent degrees/certificates.

The Distance Education Council of India/Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU)/Association of Indian Universities (AIU) are the only authority to recognize the Degrees/certificates of Distance Education. Such Applicants are provisionally permitted to appear in the VRET and will be required to submit certificates from Distance Education Council of IGNOU, New Delhi regarding recognition/approval of the courses.

- (iv) Mere appearance in the Entrance Test or securing a place in merit at the written Test does not entitle an applicant to be considered for admission to a discipline unless he/she fulfils the eligibility conditions. APPLICANTS MUST FULLY SATISFY THEMSELVES ABOUT THEIR ELIGIBILITY AS PRESCRIBED ABOVE, BEFORE FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM.

If an applicant is inadvertently allowed to appear at the Entrance Test who otherwise does not fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements, he/she cannot, at a later date, use that as a right to claim that he/she meets the eligibility requirements.

The University reserves the right to cancel/refuse admission at any point of time if it is found that:

- (a) Minimum eligibility requirements are not fulfilled.
 - (b) False documentation has been done.
 - (c) Any other similar valid reason.
- (v) Applicants appearing at the VRET shall be subject to Rules, Regulations and Ordinances relating to the University examinations. Applicants found adopting unfair means (see Section M) shall be liable to punishment as per University rules.
- (vi) (a) In case of any dispute relating to the VRET/admission to Ph.D., the decision of the University shall be final. An appeal may lie to the Vice-Chancellor, GGV against such decision. In no case any applicant shall take recourse to the court of law directly.
(b) In case of any litigation relating to the VRET/admission to Ph.D. course, the District Court of Bilaspur and the High Court of Judicature of Bilaspur shall only have the jurisdiction.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANYTHING TO THE CONTRARY CONTAINED ANYWHERE IN THE ORDINANCES OF THE UNIVERSITY, NO SCRUTINY/ RE-EVALUATION OF THE ANSWERSHEET OF THE TEST SHALL BE ALLOWED ON ANY GROUND. FURTHER, NO REPRESENTATION OR QUERY REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF THE TEST SHALL BE ENTERTAINED.

H. DIRECT ADMISSION (Without appearing in VRET)

An applicant who fulfils one of the following requirements may be considered for direct admission to the Ph. D. programme without appearing in the VRET: (Number of seats available in this category shall be as prescribed in PhD regulation 2009).

1. Applicants seeking admission in disciplines under the School of Engineering and Technology GATE qualified M.E/M.Tech. with minimum 60% of marks.
2. A applicant who has qualified National Eligibility Test as NET-JRF/NET-LS/GATE. However, in case NET- LS/GATE possesses wishes to obtain GGV fellowship they will be required to appear in VRET and get themselves admitted as VRET applicant on merit.
3. A applicant who is a recipient of National Doctoral Fellowship or other fellowships from government/semi-government organizations such as Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Department of Science and Technology (DST), Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO), Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and

similar national-level organizations awarded through an All India selection procedure conducted by the agency/ organization concerned (applicants selected in the research project funded by such organizations shall not be considered under VRET exempted category).

- (iii) An applicant who is selected under Quality Improvement Program (QIP) of AICTE, Faculty Development Programme (FDP) of a State Government or of UGC shall also be exempted from this category.
- (iv) An applicant who is sponsored as a full-time applicant by any other university/ institution/college/ government department/ public sector undertaking/ R & D organization/ private industry, who is relieved on study leave for a period of not less than two years for pursuing Ph.D. programme in a Department/ School of the University subject to fulfilling of minimum eligibility criteria.
- (v) A foreign national who is a recipient of fellowship by Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), Government of India and is sponsored by his/her government.
- (vi) A self-financing foreign national who is admitted through the Embassies/High commission of his/her country after getting approval from the Ministry of External Affairs, Govt. of India and no objection certificate from the Department of Education, Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India or admitted under an MoU.

Note:

1. The equivalence of the Degree possessed by the foreign applicants belonging to the categories at (vi) and (vii) above, shall be settled by the equivalence committee of the concerned school before their admission. They shall be admitted to the Ph.D. programme only if the degree possessed by them entitles them for enrolment as Ph. D. scholars in the universities of their own countries.
 2. The supernumerary seats for foreign nationals shall be restricted to a maximum of 15% of the total available seats in a Department/ School.
- (vii) An applicant who is already registered as a Ph.D. Scholar in some other university and whose supervisor joins this University. (however such registration must be as per UGC regulation 2009 and applicant shall produce certificate in this regard). The course work completed by such applicants in their earlier university shall be accepted the recommendation of the concerned school.
 - (vii) An applicant who is sponsored as a part-time applicant by a non-degree awarding institution/ government department/ public sector undertaking/ R & D organization/ private industry, who shall work for his/her Ph. D in his/her parent organization fulfilling the residency period requirement prescribed in the relevant ordinances. Such an applicant is required to submit a sponsorship and work experience certificate from the parent organization. The non-degree awarding institutions, government departments, public sector undertakings, R & D organizations and the private industries are only those, which are recognized as centers of research by the University as specified in the related Ordinances/Regulations.
 - (viii) A teacher of this University holding substantive post (including those on probation). For faculty of disciplines belonging to Engineering & Technology, three years teaching experience on substantive post is essential for seeking admission under VRET exempted category.
 - (ix) A non-teaching employee of this University holding substantive post including those on probation. (Subject to NOC by the University) 'Research Scientist' working in this University shall be eligible for applying under VRET exempted category. However, all the exempted applicants must apply in the prescribed VRET Application Form in order to be eligible for consideration for admission under VRET exemption category.
 - (x) The applications of the applicants belonging to the categories (iii) to (ix) above shall be routed through proper channel.

I. WRITTEN TEST: (VRET)

1. An applicant possessing the minimum qualifications with the requisite percentage of marks, as mentioned at Section C, shall be eligible to appear in the written test.
2. There shall be separate test for each discipline.
3. The test shall be of 2 hours duration, carrying 300 marks, consisting of 100 multiple-choice questions. The question paper will have two sections.
 - (i) Section- A will have 40 questions of general nature to test the quantitative ability, logical and reasoning, language skills (English) ICT skills, general knowledge etc. these questions shall be common to all the applicants in a school.
 - (ii) Section-B -In addition, there shall be 60 multiple choice questions of specialized nature related to a particular discipline of the school. The guiding syllabi for these questions shall be of NET syllabus / GPAT (for Pharmaceutical Sciences) / GATE syllabus for Engineering and Technology discipline, NET (ICAR) for forestry and GGV PG level syllabus for the concern subjects where NET/GATE is not conducted.
4. The VRET examination will be conducted in English only and medium of instruction (except languages) shall also be English.
5. **There shall be no negative marking.** Three marks shall be awarded for each correct answer; Un-attempted questions shall be awarded zero marks.
6. No scrutiny/revaluation of the answer books of the written test shall be allowed.

Cut off Marks: For qualifying in the written test (VRET) an applicant shall have to secure a minimum 50% of aggregate marks. The qualifying marks for ST/SC/PH applicants shall be 45%. The university reserves the right to modifying the qualifying marks.

J. APPLICATION PROCESSING/TEST FEE:

A applicant desirous of appearing in VRET or VRET (Exempted Category) shall pay the Test Fee of Rs.600/- in case of General/OBC and Rs.250/- in case of SC/ST/ PC Category along with the Application Form through a crossed Demand Draft (DD) issued by any Nationalized/Scheduled Bank or SBI Challan in favour of the “**The Registrar, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya**”, payable at **Bilaspur** or by Cash deposited at Punjab National Bank or Bank of India Branch situated in University Campus through Bank challan issued from the University Counter (Administrative building).

Applicant submitting the application online can deposit fee through State Bank of India (SBI) Challan generated after online registration. The Challan can be print and after depositing the fee on any SBI branch, applicant can log in by ID & Date of Birth (Password) for online filling the form. *Fee can also be deposited by online payment mode. Please also attach the receipt of successful transaction by online payment along with application form.*

NOTE:

- (i) The applicant is advised to write his/her name, name of the main discipline, code number of main discipline on the reverse of the Demand Draft (issued by a Bank) for offline application.
- (ii) The processing fee paid shall neither be refunded nor transferred to another course and shall also not be reserved for any subsequent year, in any case.
- (iii) The applicant is advised to ensure that the Demand Draft (issued by a Bank) fulfills the following requirements:
 - In favour of: “Registrar, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya”, payable at Bilaspur.
 - It clearly mentions: (a) Date of issue (b) Name & Code No. of issuing branch (c) Name &

Code no. of Drawee Branch (d) Signature of the authorized person along with specimen signature (e) Amount in words and figures (f) Applicant's name, name of the main discipline and code number of main discipline on the back of the draft.

IMPORTANT: If the Demand Draft is incomplete/incorrectly drawn or is a non-MICR, the applicant will be disqualified unless he/she resubmits the corrected Demand Draft along with additional fee of Rs.150/-.

K. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM:

APPLICATION FORM: Application forms can be submitted online / offline both.

Off Line Submission: The Application Form is required to be filled *by the applicant* in CAPITAL letters (except signature) using either ink or ball point pen in HIS/HER OWN HAND WRITING. Forms filled in by pencil will not be accepted. Where information is required to be filled in boxes, only one alphabet is to be written in each box. While writing names in capital letters, leave one box blank between first and middle name and also between middle and last name or initials of names. **Your Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and Date of Birth in the Application Form should be exactly the same as mentioned in the High School/Class X certificate. Any discrepancy, whenever discovered, may lead to cancellation of your candidature.**

While providing information for various questions/items, tick ✓ the appropriate box (by ball point pen) applicable to you for that question/item while the remaining boxes relating to that question/item should be kept blank.

1. **Description of Demand Draft:** Write Name, Address and Code No. of the Issuing Branch, DD No., Date and Amount in the appropriate boxes provided for these. Also, on the reverse of Bank Draft, the applicant should write: (a) Name of the applicant (b) Main Discipline name (in which applicant is to appear in VRET) (c) Main Discipline Code number and (d) Application Form No.
2. **Photograph :** Paste your recent colour photograph inside the box given for the purpose. Application Forms with Xerox copy of photograph shall be rejected out rightly. Keep sufficient number of extra copies of the same photograph (at least 4 numbers) for future use in case you are admitted. The photograph should be the most recent showing the latest appearance and should show frontal view of full face against a light background. The eyes and the ears should be visible. Photos taken with coloured or dark glasses are not acceptable.
3. **Admission Category in VRET:** The applicant has two options under this item. He or she can take admission either through i) VRET; ii) VRET Exempted category only if eligible in this category.

The applicant should darken the circle appropriate for his/her case and leave the other two circles blank. Before darkening the circle the applicant should satisfy himself/herself that the applicant is eligible for admission under that category.

Example: i) If the applicant is applying for admission in Physics in the School of Physical Science and does not come under the category of VRET Exempted, then he/she should darken the circle for VRET.

Example: ii) If the applicant is applying for admission in Electronics, in the School of Physical Sciences and has a valid NET score card, then he/she should darken the circle for VRET Exempted Electronics.

Example: iii) If the applicant is applying for admission in Hindi in the School of Arts and is NET JRF **then he/she should darken the circle for VRET exempted Hindi.**

Note: If an applicant intends to take admission in the Faculty of Physical Science, through VRET and he/she is also eligible for admission in other faculty due to having GATE score card/NET-JRF/NET-LS and wishes to attempt for admission in the two faculties then he/she should apply on separate Application forms for the two disciplines. Similarly, a NET-LS/GATE applicant wishing admission in a Faculty as VRET

exempted category applicant but also wishing to appear as VRET category for getting GGV Scholarship should apply on separate application forms for above purpose.

4. Name of the Main Discipline for admission: The names of the main disciplines are given in Section E. (DISCIPLINE NAME & DISCIPLINE CODE NUMBER). The name of the Main Discipline should be written legibly in CAPITAL letters.
5. **Discipline Code Number:** The code numbers of the disciplines are also given in Section - E. The appropriate discipline code number for the discipline for which the applicant intends to appear in VRET **OR** wishes to take admission through VRET-Exempted category should be given in the appropriate three boxes allotted for the discipline code number. In case of non-concurrence between discipline name & discipline code number, the discipline name will be taken to be final.

If you belong to Physically Challenged category, then you should darken the appropriate circle of your type of disability also. 17. **Details of Educational qualifications: Here you should give your educational details.**
18. **Signature of the Applicant:** Here you should sign in your usual handwriting inside the given box for signature (**do not sign in capital letters**). This signature will be used for preparing Admit Card.

- (vi) Submission of Application Form by an applicant after erasing the entries made earlier by another applicant.
- (vii) Test Fee once paid at concessional rate meant for SC/ST applicants shall in no case be accepted under 'General Category' even if such applicants offer to pay the difference later.

The university takes no responsibility for any delay or loss of application form or correspondence in postal transit/courier transit.

PROVISIONAL ADMIT CARD indicating the venue of the test for appearing the examination can be **downloaded by the applicant from the university web site**. On the Application Form, the applicant should write neatly his/her complete postal address with pin code. University shall not be responsible for any delay in communication caused due to wrong/incomplete address given by the applicant or any delay/loss in postal transit. If an applicant does not receive any communication till a week before the date of the Test, he/she should contact the Office of “**THE DEPUTY REGISTRAR (ACADEMIC), ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING GURU GHASIDAS VISHWAVIDYALAYA, KONI, BILASPUR, CHHATTISGARH - 495009, INDIA.**”. 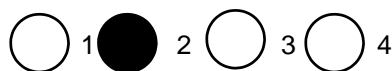
R. TEST CENTRE:

The Common Research Entrance Test (VRET) shall be conducted at Bilaspur, University Campus only, on **24th May 2015**. (Sunday)

S. METHOD OF ANSWERING IN THE TEST:

- (i) A Question Booklet containing the questions and a separate Answer Sheet shall be provided to the applicant at the beginning of the Test.
- (ii) The applicant, within 10 minutes of the issue of the Questions Booklet, shall check the Question Booklet to ensure that it contains all the pages in correct sequence and that no page/question is missing. In case of faulty Question Booklet, the applicant shall immediately bring it to the notice of the Superintendent / Invigilators to obtain a fresh Question Booklet.
- (iii) The applicant is required to write his/her *Roll Number, Question Booklet No. and Set No.*, if any, at the appropriate places provided in the answer sheet in INK/Ball Point pen only. In addition, he/she is also required to fill up Roll Number in the space provided at the bottom of the answer sheet by darkening the appropriate circles by Blue/Black Ball Point pen only.
- (iv) The applicant is required to write in INK/Ball Point pen only, his/her Roll number and Serial Number of Answer Sheet at the appropriate places on the cover page of the Question Booklet.
- (v) Each question shall be followed by four alternative answers. The applicant is required to identify the one which he/she feels to be the correct answer and record the answer by darkening the appropriate circle in the answer sheet with Blue/Black Ball Point pen only, as will also be mentioned in the guidelines given on the first page of the Answer Sheet. For example, if out of 4 alternatives (1) (2) (3) & (4) given against question No. 15 the applicant identifies (2) as the correct answer, then he/she is required to darken the *circle No. 2 only* in the Answer Sheet as given below:

- (vi) The answer will be treated incorrect if more than one circle is darkened or a circle is darkened improperly. Any other method of marking such as tick mark, cross mark, use of dot, line mark and half-filled circle or marks outside the circle shall not be evaluated.
- (vii) If any question is not attempted, the applicant is required to leave all the circles against that question as blank. Such an answer will be awarded *zero* marks.
- (viii) Inner cover page of the Question Booklet or the blank space/page of the end of Question Booklet may be used for rough work.
- (ix) No page from the Question Booklet is to be torn or removed. If an applicant is found tearing any page from the Question Booklet he/she shall be liable to punishment for adopting unfair means and shall not be allowed to continue in the Entrance Test.

IMPORTANT

- (i) APPLICANTS TO NOTE THAT, SINCE ANSWERS ARE TO BE MARKED IN INK, IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO CHANGE ANY ANSWER AFTER MARKING IT.
- (ii) Applicants found using/adopting unfair means in the VRET shall be disqualified from the test and also shall be debarred from admission even for any other course in future in GGU. An applicant shall appear in the test as per rules, regulations and ordinances of the University framed from time to time.
- (iii) Not withstanding anything to the contrary contained anywhere in the ordinances of the University, no scrutiny/ revaluation of the answer book of the test shall be allowed on any ground. Further, no representation or any enquiry regarding the conduct of the test shall be entertained.

T. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS APPEARING IN VRET:

- (i) The Applicant must carry his/her valid Admit Card for the Test. He/She must occupy only his/her allotted seat as per his/her Roll Number in the seating arrangement made for the Test.
- (ii) No Applicant shall be allowed to the Test Hall after 30 minutes of the start of the Entrance Test.
- (iii) No Applicant shall be allowed to leave the Test Hall till the end of the Test.
- (iv) There is no provision to provide or permit a 'writer' in the Entrance Test except for blind applicants, who will be provided 'writers' on request [For details please refer to Section C of this Information Bulletin].
- (v) The Applicants shall be checked for any resource materials frequently and at random by the Invigilators and other staff conducting the Test, routinely and also on the slightest doubt.
- (vi) Calculators/watch calculators, electronic diary, pager, mobile phones, earphones, alarm clock, digital watches with memory, slide rule, etc. are not allowed in the examination hall. Also, carrying of licensed weapon, fire arms, tools which can be used as lethal weapons are not allowed in the examination hall. However, Scientific calculator is allowed in the examination hall for the subjects in Engineering & Technology only.
- (vii) The VRET of a applicant shall be cancelled in case of any of the following actions by a applicant: Relevant or irrelevant resource material or loose paper found on his/her possession, or, lying on or around his/her seat, Possession of any unauthorized instrument or equipment as mentioned at (vi) above/document/paper/ information materials or any resource materials, Communication of information in writing or verbally or exchange of Question Booklet/Answer Sheets to and from any other person during the Entrance Test period and any other malpractice amounting to obtaining undue advantage, Writing anything on the Admit Card, Carrying of the envelope of the Admit Card and seating plan into the examination hall, Any alterations or corrections in the entries made by a applicant in Question Booklet and OMR Sheet [Roll Number in words & figures and OMR sheet no. in Question Booklet and Roll Number, Question Booklet no. and Set no. (if any) in OMR sheet] but not duly verified by the invigilator concerned, Non-matching of signature made at the time of VRET with that already done at the time of filling of Application Form.
- (viii) **The VRET of an applicant shall be cancelled and applicant shall be debarred to appear from future Tests in case of any of the following actions by an applicant:**

Tampering with the Admit Card including that of the photograph, face not resembling the photograph on the Admit Card, not occupying the allotted seat, tampering/disturbing the seating arrangements, smuggling-out or smuggling-in Question Booklet in part or in full, or Test material, or any resource material connected with the Test, Making any attempt to influence the University authorities directly or indirectly, Disturbing or trying to disturb the VRET, Noting down the questions or their answers, Shouting of slogans or creating unruly scene at the examination hall/examination center/University campus.
- (ix) **Impersonation is a legally punishable offence.** No Applicant will be permitted to appear in the Test without a valid Admit Card. The Admit Card should be presented to the invigilators/other authorized officials for verification. The applicant's identity will be verified in respect of his/her details on the Admit Card/Registration Form (Form 'B'). If the identity is in doubt, the applicant may not be allowed to appear in the Test. The authorities may at their discretion provisionally permit the applicant to appear in the Test after completing formalities including taking of thumb impression/several signatures for further verification. No extra time will be granted for these formalities to be completed.

Similarly, at the time of Subjective Test/Personal Interview and admission, the applicant's identity will be verified from the documents available with the University and in case of any doubt, his/her admission will be deferred till final verification.

A person found to impersonate an applicant shall be handed over to the Police under an FIR lodged by the University. The applicant in reference shall be debarred from future Entrance Tests of the University.

A student or employee of the University if found to impersonate in the Test will be respectively rusticated or dismissed from the University service.

- (x) **Suppression/concealment of information:** The applicant must ensure that he/she is qualified to appear in the Test. If it is detected at any stage that he/she did not fulfill the minimum eligibility requirement or there was something against the applicant which would have prevented him/her from being admitted in the concerned discipline, or, the applicant has provided false information or no information about his/her previous involvement in an act punishable under law or act of gross misconduct and indiscipline, then his/her candidature shall not be considered and his/her admission if already made shall be cancelled at any stage and he/she shall be debarred from appearing in any of the future Test of the University.
- (xi) Nobody other than the University authorized personnel is permitted to move around the Test venue. Any unauthorized persons loitering around the Test venue shall be handed over to the police under an FIR lodged by the University.
- (xii) No scrutiny/re-evaluation of answer sheet of the Test is allowed in any case at any stage.
- (xii) The applicant shall be bound by the GGU Statutes/Ordinances/Rules and Regulations framed from time to time.
- (xiii) Any litigation in respect of the Test shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the local Court of Bilaspur and/or Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bilaspur only.

U. ADMISSION:

Mere fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements shall not entitle any applicant for admission to Ph.D. Course also no applicant shall be considered for registration for Ph.D. course if (i) he/she fails to submit all the required certificates in original at the time of counseling /interview or (ii) there is no availability of vacant seats in the discipline.

The admission shall be based on the merit of the applicants, which shall be determined separately for the applicants seeking admission through VRET and through Direct Admission. The merit lists shall be based on the total marks obtained by the applicants from the components as mentioned hereunder:

Merit List: The merit list shall be prepared by duly constituted committee

The number of seats available shall be notified at the time of counseling by the department/school.

The Head of the Department/Coordinator of the school shall then issue the letter of admission to the applicants. On receipt of the letter of admission, each applicant shall pay the prescribed fees and complete other official formalities pertaining to admission within the stipulated time (generally 3 days). The information regarding admission of VRET – Exempted applicants shall be sent by the respective Deans of the Schools.

V. REGISTRATION OF FOREIGN NATIONALS:

Applications of Foreign Nationals nominated by the Govt. of India under scholarship scheme and self- financing Foreign Nationals shall be entertained. The foreign nationals need not appear in the entrance test for admission. However, they should have passed *the equivalent Qualifying Examination from an Indian or Foreign University / Institution.*

Provision to the extent of 15% of the total seats in each Discipline on supernumerary basis for Foreign Nationals is available: Out of which 5% seats be filled up by children of NRIs [Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)] and 5% by children of Indian workers in Gulf and South Asian

Countries. All the foreign nationals have to fulfill the following conditions: -

i). At the time of submitting the application

- (i) All the foreign nationals should submit their applications, along with the **processing fee**, on prescribed format, which can be freely downloaded from the website www.ggu.ac.in.
- (ii) The applications of scholarship-holding Foreign Nationals (under various schemes) are routed through the Indian Council for Cultural Relations/Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Education), Govt. of India, New Delhi.
- (iii) They should hold a valid foreign passport.
- (iv) The antecedents of the applicant have been verified by the forwarding Agencies/Ministry and found in order.
- (v) They should have adequate knowledge of English and/or Hindi as per the requirements of the Course.

ii). At the time of admission

- (i) They should have valid Residential permit in India granted for studies/ Student Visa for the prescribed duration of the concerned Course.
- (ii) They should fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements.

iii). General

- The Degrees/certificates of the applicants have been recognized and approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/Commonwealth Universities/International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/certificates.
- All the eligible foreign nationals are required to fill up the Registration Form prescribed by the University at the time of admission.
- The *inter-se* merit among the applicants of various foreign nationals will be decided by the "Core Committee for Admissions of Foreign Nationals", which shall be deemed as final.

Further details regarding admission of foreign nationals are available on the website www.ggu.ac.in which is updated periodically.

FEE FOR THE FOREIGN NATIONALS*:

Fee structure for all the categories of foreign nationals is as under (Fee details available on website)

1. Processing fee (50 / 100 US \$) : At the time of submitting the application
2. Usual Course fee (in INR) : At the time of joining the course
3. Additional fee (US \$) : At the time of joining the course

The quantum of processing fee and additional fee may be modified by GGU from time to time.

* Subject to change as per university norms.

W. FELLOWSHIP:

All the eligible internal full-time research scholars of university teaching departments admitted through VRET not getting any financial assistance from any funding agency will be entitled for fellowship of Rs.8000.00 per month and contingency of Rs.10000.00 per year for science students and Rs.8000.00 per year for Humanities and Social Science Students as per UGC Norms/ University Ph. D. Ordinance/regulation).

"The fellowship privilege for the scholars involved in acts of indiscipline (on record) may not be extended."

X. RESULT:

Results of the applicants appeared in VRET shall be available on www.ggu.ac.in. No queries regarding result shall be entertained. Applicants are also advised to contact the concern department after declaration of result.
