1.	What is All India Pre-Veterinary Test (AIPVT)?	AIPVT is an Entrance Test conducted by the Veterinary Council of India for filling up 15% of All India Quota seats in the Veterinary Colleges in India (except from Jammu & Kashmir State).										
2.	Which are the States, Universities and Institutions participating in AIPVT 2015 for filling up of B.V.Sc. & A.H. (Degree Course) seats under their control?	AIPVT is conducted for filling up 15% of All India Quota seats in the Veterinary Colleges in India. List of Veterinary Colleges where seats may be available under 15% All India Quota are given in Information Bulletin of AIPVT-2015 at Appendix VIII.										
3.	Whether the examination will be offline or online?	AIPVT 2015 will be an offline pen and paper test.										
4.	What is the examination date for AIPVT 2015?	The date of examination is 20 th June, 2015 (Saturday 2.00 to 5.00 P.M.).										
5.	What is the syllabus for AIPVT 2015?	The syllabus is given in the Information Bulletin of AIPVT-2015 at Appendix-II										
6. 15.	If a candidate for any reason not appearing or appeared in the examination is there any provision for fee refund?	No. Once the online application form is submitted successfully by the candidate, it cannot be withdrawn. Claims for refund of application fee will not be entertained under any circumstances.																	
16.	What is the minimum and maximum age for appearing in AIPVT 2015 for 15% All India Quota seats?	<p>The candidates should be an Indian National (except from the State of Jammu & Kashmir).</p> <p>A candidate who has attained or will attain the age of Seventeen (17) years as on 31st December, 2015 are eligible for AIPVT-2015. Candidates attaining seventeen years on 1st of January, 2016 or later will not be eligible to appear at the AIPVT-2015.</p> <p>The upper age limit for candidates seeking admission under 15% All India Quota Seats is 25 years as on 31st December, 2015. Further provided that this upper age limit shall be relaxed by a period of 5 (five) years for the candidates of Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes.Candidate must be born on or between</p> <p>(a) 01/01/86 to 01/01/99 (SC/ST/OBC Category) (b) 01/01/91 to 01/01/99 (General Category)</p>																	

17.	Is candidate from Jammu & Kashmir eligible for 15% All India Quota seats?	<p>(a) Candidates from the State of Jammu & Kashmir are NOT ELIGIBLE for 15% All India Quota seats as the provisions of the Indian Veterinary Council Act 1984 have not been extended to the State of Jammu & Kashmir. If they claim eligibility, they must upload Self Declaration, as per proforma given in Appendix-III on a Plain Paper to the effect that:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. They are not eligible to seek admission for B.V.Sc & A.H. Course in Veterinary Colleges in the State of Jammu & Kashmir. ii. They are not domiciled in Jammu & Kashmir <p>(b) Online Applications Form not supported with the required scanned Self Declaration in original as per format given at Appendix-III or incomplete, unsigned or photocopy of the Self Declaration shall be summarily rejected without any further reference in the matter.</p> <p>(c) The Self Declaration made by such candidates will be verified and if found to be false, the admission of all such candidates shall be cancelled and criminal proceedings may be initiated against them.</p> <p>(d) Candidates from State of Jammu & Kashmir shall have to submit an affidavit as per Appendix-IV on Non Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.10/- duly attested by Metropolitan Magistrate/ First Class Judicial Magistrate at the time of Counseling.</p> <p>Appendix-III and Appendix-IV are given in Information Bulletin of AIPVT-2015</p>
18.	What are the enclosures that should be attached with the confirmation page to be sent to the VCI?	The candidates are NOT REQUIRED TO SEND the print out of the Confirmation Page or any other document (s) to the VCI.
19.	While filling up of the Application Form, wrong particulars are filled in the online form, how it will be corrected.	The application particulars entered can be edited before final submission of the application form. The application contents cannot be changed/edited once it is finally submitted.
20.	Is a candidate passed class XII with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology and English subjects from NIOS, eligible to appear for AIPVT?	Yes, any candidate passed class XII examination with an aggregate of 50% marks in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Bio-Technology) and also passed English in the Qualifying Examination from any recognised Board/University can appear in the AIPVT subject to other conditions as given in Information Bulletin..
21.	If a student studied up to class 11 th from a Board outside India and class XII from a Board in India, will he/she be eligible to appear in AIPVT-2015.	Yes. All Indian Nationals are Eligible to appear in the AIPV-2015 for 15% All India Quota Seats.
22.	Is it compulsory to take Maths if one want to appear in AIPVT-2015?	It is not necessary to offer Maths to appear in AIPVT-2015.
23.	Candidate passed 12 th class in the subjects of English, Hindi, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physical education and appeared/appearing seperately for Biology subject from another	No. Any examination equivalent to class XII examination of a recognized Board/University comprising of Physics, Chemistry and Biology including practical test in these subjects and English Core is only eligible to appear in AIPVT-2015.

	Board or same Board will be eligible for AIPVT-2015.	
24.	Can a candidate, appearing in Class XII in the year 2015, is eligible to appear in AIPVT 2015?	Yes, A candidate who is taking the qualifying examination prior to the AIPVT, or whose result is awaited, may also apply and take the examination but he/she shall not be eligible for admission to the B.V.Sc. & A.H. course, if he/she does not pass the qualifying examination with the required percentage of marks as per the Minimum Standard of Veterinary Education – Degree Course (B.V.Sc & A.H.) Regulations, 2008 on or before 30 th June, 2015 and submit the documentary proof during counseling, if selected.
25.	From which date the AIPVT-2015 forms will be available.	On-line submission of Application Form can be made during 15.04.2015 to 14.05.2015 (upto 11.59 P.M.) on the Council website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in .
26.	Is the availability of forms will be online or it can be purchased from any bank or institution.	Candidates can apply for AIPVT-2015 “Online” ONLY by logging on the Council website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in The Application Form other than online mode would not be accepted, in any case.
27.	For how many attempts / numbers a student can appear for AIPVT?	There is no limit on number of Attempts for appearing in AIPVT.
28..	How to send confirmation Page of Application Form of AIPVT 2015?	The candidates are NOT REQUIRED TO SEND the print out of the Confirmation Page or any other document (s) to the VCI.
29..	Can one send confirmation page of online application through courier?	No. The candidates are NOT REQUIRED TO SEND the print out of the Confirmation Page or any other document (s) to the VCI.
30.	What is the scheduled date for hosting of Admit Cards for AIPVT 2015 on website?	The tentative schedule for hosting of Admit Cards on website is 29 th May, 2015.
31.	When will be the result of AIPVT 2015 declared?	By 1 st week of July, 2015
32.	How does one know the complete guidelines/instructions for AIPVT 2015?	The details for AIPVT 2015 are available in the Information Bulletin of AIPVT 2015 which is available on the website www.aipvt.vci.nic.in .
33.	Will admission for seats other than 15% All India quota is through AIPVT 2015?	No.
34.	Will there be negative marking in AIPVT?	Yes. For each correct response the candidate will get 3 marks. For each incorrect response, one mark will be deducted.
35.	How long the result of AIPVT 2015 is valid?	The result of successful candidates of AIPVT 2015 is valid for the academic session 2015-16 only.

37.	Can anyone cancel the application submitted for AIPVT-2015?	Online Application forms once submitted successfully cannot be cancelled.
38.	What do the candidates need to bring to the exam centre?	<p>Candidates should bring only following material on the day of examination inside the Examination Room/ Hall:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Admit Card downloaded from Council's website. ➤ Card Board/ Clip Board on which nothing should have been written, so that they have no difficulty in writing/markings responses in the OMR Answer Sheet even if the tables provided in the examination room/hall do not have smooth surface. ➤ Blue/Black Ball Point pen for writing/markings responses on Test Booklet and OMR Answer Sheet. Use of pencil is not allowed. These will not be supplied by the Centre Superintendent. ➤ Postcard size photograph pasted on the proforma downloaded with the Admit Card ➤ Passport size photograph to be pasted on the specific space in the attendance sheet.
39.	Can the candidate bring anything other than that mentioned in S.No.39 above to the examination centre?	<p>Candidates are not allowed to carry any textual material, Calculators, Docu Pen, Slide Rules, Log Tables and Electronic Watches with facilities of calculator, printed or written material, bits of papers, mobile phone, Blue-tooth devices, pager or any other electronic gadget/ device etc.</p> <p>The candidates are prohibited to bring any kind of electronic gadgets/device in the examination room/hall. If any candidate is in possession of any of the above item, his/her candidature will be treated as unfair means and lead to cancellation of the current examination & also debar the candidate for future examination(s) & the material will be seized.</p> <p>Hence, candidate should not carry any other things other than mentioned in S. NO. 39 above in the examination room/hall.</p>
40.	Will any candidate be able to leave early if he finishes the test before the allocated test time?	No candidate will leave the examination hall/room before the test concludes.
41. 44.	Is there any provision for re-checking of answer sheet?	Evaluation of Answer Sheet will be done by scanning through Optical Mark Reader (OMR). As the Answer Sheets are computer readable and evaluated with extreme care and are repeatedly scrutinised coupled with physical verification at random, there shall be no provision for re-checking or re-evaluation of Answer Sheets. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
45.	Is there any provision to challenge the response(s) against the OMR grading?	Evaluation of Answer Sheet will be done by scanning through Optical Mark Reader (OMR). As the Answer Sheets are computer readable and evaluated with extreme care and are repeatedly scrutinised coupled with physical verification at random, there shall be no provision for re-checking or re-evaluation of Answer Sheets.
46.	What is the Entry time at the Examination Hall?	The examination room/hall will be opened 60 minutes before the commencement of test. Candidates should take their seat immediately after opening of the examination hall. If the candidates do not report in time due to any reason i.e. traffic jam, train/bus delay etc, they are likely to miss some of the general instructions to be announced in the Examination Rooms/Halls. The Council shall not be responsible for any delay. A candidate who reports at the examination center after the commencement of the examination shall not be permitted to sit in the examination.
