

## CONSTITUENT COLLEGES/INSTITUTES OFFERING UG DEGREE COURSES FISHERIES COLLEGE AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE, THOOTHUKUDI



The Fisheries College was started at Thoothukudi by Tamil Nadu Agricultural University (TNAU) in October, 1977 as the second fisheries college in India. It was brought under Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (TANUVAS) on 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1989. The college was renamed as Fisheries College and Research Institute (FC&RI) in 1990 to focus more on research and extension activities. The FC&RI has three campuses: the Main Campus, the staff quarters complex and Mariculture Research Farm Facility located at Tharuvaikulam, a coastal village 17 km away from the main campus, for undertaking Mariculture / Coastal Aquaculture activities. FC&RI, Thoothukudi has been accredited by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Govt. of India, New Delhi for a period of 5 years from 2021-22 to 2025-26. This institute offers professional degree programmes such as B.F.Sc., M.F.Sc. and Ph.D. The college has eight departments and a well-established Digitized Library and offers M.F.Sc. and Ph.D. degree programmes in nine disciplines. The campus provides separate hostel facilities for boys and girls with fully secured Wi-Fi connectivity.

Dr. M.G.R. Fisheries College and Research Institute, Ponneri was started as the Institute of Fisheries Technology, Ponneri on 20.02.2013 by the Government of TamilNadu. Subsequently, the institute was upgraded as a college, which is currently functioning with seven departments. ## Dr. M.G.R. FISHERIES COLLEGE AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE, THALAINAYERU



Dr. MGR Fisheries College and Research Institute was established at Oradiyampulam, Thalainayeru during 2017. This institute offers B.F.Sc. degree programme from academic year 2017-18. The college has been accredited by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Govt. of India, New Delhi for a period of 5 years from 2021-22 to 2025-26. The Institute of Fisheries Technology was established at Nagapattinam during 2012. Subsequently the Institute of Fisheries Technology has been renamed as College of Fisheries Engineering considering the growing importance and emerging needs of fisheries engineering of fisheries sector. The College of Fisheries Engineering located in Nagapattinam campus has six departments and offers a four-year B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering) professional degree programme from the academic year 2015–16. This institute also offers M.Tech. programme in two disciplines. ### 3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO PROFESSIONAL DEGREE COURSES

- Candidates belonging to Tamil Nadu State alone are eligible to apply {except for B.F.Sc. [ICAR quota] and B. Tech. (Biotechnology) & B.B.A. (Fisheries Enterprises Management) [Other State quota]}.
- Tamil Nadu candidates who have not studied VIII to XII standards in Tamil Nadu should produce the Certificate of Permanent Residence in Tamil Nadu in the prescribed proforma (Certificate I) issued by the competent authorities. Candidates possessing community certificate issued by Government of Tamil Nadu need not submit Certificate I.
- A pass in the Higher Secondary Course in 10+2 pattern (State Board / CBSE / any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto) examination and fulfilling the following requirements are eligible.

#### 3.1. Eligibility for admission to paraprofessional courses: B.Voc. (IFPT), B.Voc. (IA) and B.Voc. (IFT)

- Candidate from academic/ vocational stream.
- A pass in the Higher Secondary Course (State Board/ CBSE/ any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto).
- Degree holders are also eligible. However, only H.Sc. marks will be considered for admission.

#### 3.2. Number of Attempts

The maximum number of attempts made in passing the qualifying examination is limited to **three** for SC/ SCA /ST candidates and **two** for other candidates. However, these conditions do not apply to the candidates applying for vocational degree (B.Voc.) courses.

The aggregate calculation pattern followed for the academic stream applicants shall also be adopted for the vocational stream-studied students. The marks obtained in all four eligible subjects will be converted to 50 marks each and the aggregate mark will be arrived at.

### 3.3.2. Normalization of Marks

As per Tamil Nadu Act No. 3 of 2007, dated 05.03.2007 and G.O. (Ms) No. HE (J2) Dept, date: 05.04.2007, the marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or Authorities shall be equated with the marks obtained by them in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board of Tamil Nadu by adopting the method of normalization.

### 3.4. AGE LIMIT

Candidates applying for the above said courses (except B.Voc.) should not have completed the age mentioned below as on **01-07-2024**.

- SC/SCA/ST Candidates : No age limit
- Other candidates : 21years
- Differently abled : 26years

**Note: There is no age limit to the candidates applying for 3 year B.Voc degree courses.**

### 3.5. RESERVATION

The reservations will be followed as per the orders of the Government of Tamil Nadu in vogue at the time of admission.

The list of communities eligible to compete against the reserved quota is furnished in **Appendix- I.**

- a) Tamil Nadu native candidates alone will be considered for communal reservation. The community recorded in the certificate of Tamil Nadu native candidate should appear in the list of communities approved by the Government of Tamil Nadu. (APPENDIX-I)
- b) The applicants from Tamil Nadu State should have obtained permanent community certificate in permanent card format/electronic form/digitally signed e-Certificate only from the appropriate authorities on or before the last date prescribed for submission of online application. Community Certificates obtained after the last date prescribed for submission of online applications will not be considered.
- c) Community Certificate obtained from other states will not be considered for communal reservation.

**Note:**

Few seats are reserved (within the actual sanctioned strength) for **special categories** such as Differently-abled, Sports persons and Children of Ex-servicemen, Students studied at TN Government Schools and students from the vocational stream. A special processing fee of Rs.100/special reservation (except 7.5% quota) is to be paid along with the online application fee. (**Campus transfer is not permissible for candidates admitted under special reservation quota on any account / circumstances**).

### 3.6. Special Reservations

#### i. Differently- abled

Five percent (5 %) of the total number of seats is reserved for the differently-abled candidates. This reservation is provided only for the category of **locomotory disorders of**

**lower limbs ranging from 40% to 70%.** Any other disability will not be considered. Candidates with less than 40% of disabilities are not eligible for reservation, However shall apply for Undergraduates degree programme under communal category. However, such candidates have to submit physical fitness certificate. The maximum age limit is relaxed to 26 years. The other conditions for admission to the courses are applicable as in the case of respective category.

The candidates seeking admission under this special category are expected to produce the necessary certificate from the **District Medical Board**, constituted to assess the nature and the extent of physical disability (locomotors disorders) in the format (**Certificate No. II**) prescribed in this prospectus. The medical certificate received without the specific recommendation of the District Medical Board will not be considered for selection under this special category. The eligible candidates called for counselling will have to appear for a physical examination before a Medical Officer at the time of counseling. The certificate has to be uploaded in the column specified.

The differently-abled candidates of Tamil Nadu selected for admission will be exempted from paying **tuition fees** of the total admission fees prescribed by the University.

#### ii. **Eminent Sports Persons:**

The candidates of Academic Stream who wish to apply for B.F.Sc. degree course under sports quota should have to upload their copies of the best-awarded certificates (Sports Meet / Tournaments / Competitions and secured I, II or III place and / or participated in individual events/ team games at the International / National / State/District level) among last 4 years as per the table given (in application form) and upload their relevant sports certificates (not exceeding each **500 kb in PDF**) at the time of filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced for verification at the time of counselling.

**Note: Only one highest achievement in a year for the last four years will alone be considered. A candidate can list a maximum of FOUR highest achievements. Selection of the candidate will be based on the sports marks obtained by following the guidelines given in prospectus (Appendix II).**

#### iii. **Children of Ex- Servicemen:**

The candidates from Academic Stream, who wish to apply for B.F.Sc. degree course under Children of Ex-Servicemen Quota should have to upload their relevant supporting documents (**Certificate No. III**, not exceeding **500 kb in PDF**) when filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced for verification at the time of counselling.

#### iv. **Vocational Stream Candidates:**

Five percent (5 %) of the total number of seats in B.F.Sc. degree course is reserved for the candidates studied under the Vocational Stream of H.Sc.

The candidates from the Vocational Stream shall be considered for admission to B.F.Sc. degree course only against the seats reserved for them and they will not be considered under any other categories. But they are eligible to apply to all B.Voc. Programmes.

**v. Students Studied from Tamil Nadu Government School:**

Seven and half percent (7.5%) of seats on “preferential basis” are reserved for students studied from Tamil Nadu Government schools in admission to B.F.Sc. / B.Tech. (FE) / B.Tech. (EEE) /B.Tech. (BT) / B.Tech. (FT)/ B.B.A. (FEM) courses. These students should have studied from Class VI to XII in the Tamil Nadu Government Schools.

**vi. Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) Quota for B.F.Sc. only:**

Fifteen percent (15%) of the total number of seats in B.F.Sc. degree course is allotted to **Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thoothukudi, Dr.MGR Fisheries College and Research Institute, Ponneri and Dr. MGR Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thalainayeru** for the candidates selected by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research through CUET (UG).

**vii. Sri Lankan Tamil Refugee students**

Two seats are allotted to B.F.Sc. degree course for Sri Lankan Tamil Refugee students studied in Tamil Nadu shall be considered under **open competition**. Candidates applying under this special category should have to upload the following certificates (file not exceeding 500 kb in PDF) at the time of filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced at the time of counselling for verification.

- Identification certificate from Headquarters Tahsildar
- Those who have not registered in the Refugee camp should produce original passport, Visa and letter registered with police station.

**viii. Other state quota**

Fifteen percentage (15%) of seats are allotted for the other state candidates to study B.Tech. (Biotechnology) and B.B.A. (FEM).

**3.7. Seats reserved over and above the admission strength (Supernumerary)**

**i. Fishermen Wards (5%): 6 seats for B.F.Sc. and 1 seat for B.Tech. (FE):**

The candidates will be considered for admission in the following order of priority, irrespective of their cut-off marks. If more than one application in the same category is received, then the selection will be made based on the cut-off marks obtained by the candidates.

- a) Wards of fishermen whose father was shot dead while fishing, including by forces of another Country
- b) Wards of fishermen who were injured and disabled in accidents while fishing
- c) Wards of fishermen who have lost both parents
- d) Wards of fishermen who have lost their father only
- e) Wards of fishermen in cases where either one of their parent is a member of the Tamil Nadu Fishermen Welfare Board

Candidates applying under Fishermen ward special category should have to upload their relevant supporting documents (file not exceeding 500 kb in PDF) at the time of filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced at the time of counselling for verification. **They should invariably upload their parents' membership in the Tamil Nadu Fishermen Welfare Board.**

**Note: Semester fee, Hostel fee and Mess fee for the candidates admitted under 5% Fishermen Ward Special Category will be borne by Tamil Nadu Fishermen Welfare Board (TNFWB)**

#### **ii. Fishermen Wards (15%):**

Candidates applying under 15% Fishermen ward special category should have to upload their community certificate (file not exceeding 500 kb in PDF) at the time of filling the online application. The original certificates should be produced at the time of counselling for verification. The selection will be made based on cut-off marks obtained by the candidates.

**Note: The candidate belonging to the following fishermen community are only eligible under the Fishermen Ward 5% and 15%.**

- **Paravar (MBC-027 & 027A)**
- **Meenavar (Pattinavar, Parvatharajakulam, Sembaduvar – MBC-028)**
- **Mukkuvar or Mukayar (MBC-029)**

### iii. Ward of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non- Migrants)

One seat each in B.F.Sc. (Ponneri campus) and B.Tech. (Fisheries Engineering) degree programmes under merit basis for the Ward of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non- Migrants) living in Kashmir Valley.

### iv. Students of Andaman & Nicobar Islands

Five seats are allotted to the students of Andaman & Nicobar.

The candidates selected under self-supporting mode have to pay the **self-supporting fee** of **Rs.75000/-** (Rupees seventy-five thousand only) per semester over and above the regular fee.

**3.8. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION**

All candidates should **upload necessary documents / certificates and submit applications only through** online <https://tnagfi.ucanapply.com> on or before **06.06.2024**. Application fee has to be paid only through online.

**4. MODE OF SELECTION**

The candidate has to fill their choice of degree course and college at the time of filling their application. Selection process is done through online and/or offline counselling only on merit basis. **Calling for in-person counselling does not guarantee a seat.** Candidates will be selected on the basis of their Aggregate marks in the qualifying examination (HSC).

**Determination of the inter se merit**

In cases where more than one student has got the same aggregate marks in the general rank list, the inter se merit among such students shall be determined in the order of priority as specified below (G.O. (Ms.) No.191 (AP.6) Department dated 16.05.2007):

- ❖ Marks out of 50 in Mathematics. If a student has not studied Mathematics, marks out of 50 in Biology or (Botany + Zoology)
- ❖ Marks out of 50 in Physics
- ❖ Marks out of 50 in Chemistry
- ❖ Date of Birth – Eldest first
- ❖ Random Number

#### 4.1. ONLINE COUNSELLING

Selection process for general reservation candidates is done **through online counselling**.

- After the release of rank list, candidates shortlisted will be informed through SMS and e-mail. The ratio of 'number of vacant seats (seats to be filled)': 'number of candidates short listed for counseling' will be normally 1:5.
- During online counseling, the candidates will be allotted the Degree and College, based on their rank, community, and choice preferences made by them at the time of submission of online application.
- Online counseling system will be followed for all Degree programmes.

#### **CALLING FOR ONLINE COUNSELING DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SEAT.**

- Shortlisted candidates must pay a non-refundable counseling fee of Rs.3000/- (Rs. 1500/- for SC /SCA / ST categories) through their individual login credentials (<https://tnagfi.ucanapply.com>). Those who fail to pay counseling fee will not be considered for online counseling.
- During online counseling, the candidate is permitted to change **the order of preference for Degree and College ONLY ONCE**. An SMS and e-mail will be sent to the candidates in this regard. No modification is possible in subsequent counseling. If no modification is done, in the choice of College and Degree programme, the preferences exercised while filing the application will be considered for seat allotment.
- On the expiry of the online counseling date of the respective phase, the degree and college allotment will be done based on the choice exercised by the candidate, merit and communal reservations. The allotment will be informed to the candidates through SMS and e-mail. Detailed instructions on Admission fee payment, downloading of the Allotment letter and documents required for verification will be informed through registered email.
- The candidates who registered (Counseling fee paid) for online counseling and did not get any seat allotment, will be considered for the subsequent counseling process if vacancy arises.
- After the online counseling, candidates will be called for certificate / document verification (Ref. Appendix III). After certificate/ document verification, the candidates have to submit their original certificates to confirm the seat allotted to them.
- Before appearing for certificate verification, the candidates are required to pay an amount of Rs. 20,000/- towards admission fee by online mode before coming for certificate / document verification at TNAU, Coimbatore. Only on successful payment of admission fee, the allotment letter can be downloaded. This amount will be adjusted in their first semester fee. Paying the admission fee does not guarantee the confirmation

of seat. Confirmation will be done only after the verification of certificates / documents. Provisional admission card will be issued after successful verification.

- The admission fee (Rs.20,000/-) is **REFUNDABLE if the candidate has not registered the first semester of the degree program.**
- If any information (Marks, qualification, Community, Date of Birth, Nativity etc.,) is found incorrect, the candidature will summarily be rejected. Delay or absence for submission of certificates / documents and payment of fees will result in cancellation of seat.
- Candidates of Tamil Nadu nativity, who have applied for any one of the special reservations are also eligible for general counseling.

#### 4.2. UPWARD MOVEMENT SYSTEM

- When vacancy arises, based on the choice exercised and willingness expressed for upward movement, at the time of document verification, candidates will be moved to their best preferred upward choice of Degree and College based on merit and communal reservation.
- Upward movement system will be followed for all counseling based on arising vacancy.

#### 4.3. OFFLINE COUNSELING

Offline counseling will be conducted for the special reservations (Differently-abled, Sports Category, Ex-servicemen wards, NRI and Fishermen Wards) ahead of general counseling. Counseling for NRI will be conducted after one or two phases of general counseling.

Candidates attending special reservation counseling have to bring the necessary original document / certificate pertaining to their special reservation. If necessary valid / original documents are not produced by the candidates during the counseling, they will not be allowed to attend the counseling process.

Candidates can choose the Degree and College, based on their rank during OFFLINE counseling, attendance of candidates will be marked both at the entry and exit. Candidates have to opt for a degree and college available at the time of counseling. **DEGREE AND COLLEGE CHOICE ONCE MADE IS FINAL AND CANNOT BE CHANGED.** Upward movement will be obtained in paper form during the counseling. Candidates who have attended counselling and did not select any choice will be not considered for future counseling phase in the academic year. **CALLING FOR COUNSELING DOES NOT GUARANTEE A SEAT.** TA and DA will not be given for attending counseling. The following options exist for the candidate at the time of offline counselling.

**Note: THERE IS NO WAIT LIST OPTION IN THE COUNSELING PROCESS**

**Candidates who fail to attend the counseling at the specified date and time will forfeit their right to admission.** However, due to unforeseen and unavoidable reasons, if a candidate is unable to attend the counseling on the specified date and time, the candidate can authorize their parent/ guardian on their behalf and the parent’s /guardian’s decision will be binding and final. Such authorization letter should bear photographs of the candidate and authorized person (candidate’s parent / guardian) and signed by both the candidate and authorized person. The authorized person attending the counseling on behalf of the candidate should carry the counseling letter and photo ID proof. The format for authorization letter is provided in **Appendix VI**.

**4.4. SPOT ADMISSION**

Spot admission is an offline counseling process. **Spot admission is applicable only for the vacant seats in the self-supporting courses, vocational degree courses and B.F.Sc. in the affiliated college.** For spot admission counseling fee will be collected only from the candidates who avail a seat. After selection, the candidate must pay the counseling fee as prescribed above.

The announcement of Spot admission will be done ten days before the closure of admission. The vacancy position, college-wise and community-wise will be published on the website and also in dailies for a larger reach. Candidates will be called in a ratio of 1: 10 or more depending on the situation. Applied candidates who have not attended the counseling earlier or those who have called for the spot admission can attend the counseling. Attendance will be marked and a ranking of attended candidates will be done. Candidates will be called based on their rank for choosing the college and seat.

Selected candidates must join the college immediately by submitting the educational certificates and by paying an admission fee of Rs. 20,000/- on the day of spot admission. **Calling for Spot Admission does not necessarily GUARANTEE a seat.** No candidate

will be admitted after the announcement of "Completion of Admission" for the academic year.

If any management seat falls vacant due to migration of students from the management quota seat to the counseling quota, the management is at liberty to fill up such vacancies within five days of the closure of TNJFU admission from the rank list provided by TNJFU on merit basis.

#### **4.5. General instructions for admission under management quota in the affiliated college**

The responsibility of verifying the candidate's eligibility for admission solely rests with the affiliated college. TNJFU is not liable for answering legal queries for discrepancies or deviations if any. However, the original certificates of the candidates admitted by the affiliated college will be verified by TNJFU and if the candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Section 3, his / her candidature will not be considered even at a later stage. All seats filled in under the management quota are subject to the approval of TNJFU.

### **5. SYSTEM OF EDUCATION – Semester Course Credit System**

The medium of instruction is English in all constituent colleges and evaluation pattern in the University is "Semester Course Credit System". All UG courses (except vocational courses [6 semesters]) are of eight Semesters (4 years) duration.

The e-learning initiatives in TNJFU necessitate the use of laptops/tablets for learning as well as for assignments. Admitted candidates may have a laptop/tablet throughout their courses of study.

### **6. FEE AND DEPOSITS**

Each selected candidate is expected to pay the following tuition fees, special fees, etc., as prescribed by the University from time to time in addition to the counselling fee.

## 6.5. Fee for Affiliated Private College

Candidates admitted through counseling and management quota in the St. Devasahayam Institute of Fisheries Science and Technology, Midalam has to pay an all-inclusive, annual tuition Fee of Rs. 50,000/- as fixed by the Government of Tamil Nadu (G.O. (Ms.) 233 of Agriculture (AU) department dated 8.10.2020).

## 7. TUITION FEE CONCESSION

### 7.1. First Graduate Tuition Fee Concession

As per the G.O. (Ms) No. 85 Higher Education (J2) Department, dated 16.04.2010, the Government has ordered to grant **tuition fee concession** to the candidates, who are to be the first graduate in a family. Those who are attending counselling and joined in professional courses in Government Colleges, have to submit the following certificates for available tuition fee concession.

- (i) Certificate obtained from Headquarters Deputy Tahsildar in the form at prescribed in G.O. (Certificate No. IV).
- (ii) The candidates have to furnish Certificate No. V (Joint Declaration).

**If the Brother or Sister of the candidate has already availed First Graduate Tuition Fee concession for studying Professional Courses, then the applicant is not eligible for such concession.**

### 7.2. Government School Students full fee concession

As per the GO 221 Higher Education (J2) Dated 15.11.2021, the government of Tamil Nadu will bear the expenses for education in professional courses of students admitted under the 7.5% reservation for government school students. They have to submit proof for Government School study details from the Sixth Standard to the Twelfth Standard. The following categories of schools are classified as Government schools.

- Government Schools
- Government Corporation Schools
- Government Municipal Schools
- Government Forest Schools
- Government Adi Dravida and Tribal Welfare Schools
- Government Kallar Reclamation Schools

## 8. SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships such as SC/ST Welfare and Backward Class scholarships, Scholarships given by Govt. of India, Government of Tamil Nadu, Indian Council of Agricultural Research and Pattukottai Azhagiri Endowment scholarship are available for deserving candidates.

## 9. HOSTEL FACILITIES

- a) Hostels for the students are available in each major campus and the messes are run on a dividing system.
- b) The students will be accommodated in the hostels to the extent possible, subject to the availability.
- c) A sum of Rs.10,000/-will be collected as hostel deposit (Refundable)

## 10. PAYMENT OF FEES AND REGISTRATION AFTER SELECTION AND ADMISSION

A candidate, who has been selected for admission to undergraduate degree course, has to pay the semester fees and hostel deposits on or before the date of commencement of the classes at the respective colleges. Refund of fees will be done as per TNJFU ASR&R 1.1.9 till the closure of admission.

## 11. REPORTING TO ADMITTED COLLEGES

Newly admitted students should report to the allotted college in time as indicated in the admission letter, failing which their admission will be cancelled. No exemption or permission will be entertained in this regard.

## 12. DISCONTINUING FROM THE DEGREE COURSES

Students who are unable to continue the course for genuine reasons such as (i) inability to pay the fees, (ii) getting Government jobs for their SSLC / HSC qualifications, (iii) becoming physically handicapped during study and similar genuine cases will be permitted to discontinue. **All other cases who desire to leave the degree programme after the closure of UG admission (2024-25) or on any date of subsequent years irrespective of the fact should pay a sum of Rs. 2.00 lakhs.**

The selected candidates and his /her parent/guardian will have to execute an agreement bond (**Appendix IV & V**) during admission. Failure to execute the agreement bond will lead to cancellation of selection.

## 13. PREVENTION OF RAGGING

Ragging is punishable as per Proceedings of the Supreme Court of India in SLP (C) No. 24295/2004 conveyed by the University Grants Commission, vide Letter No.F.1-8/2006 (Cp-II) dated: 04.03.2008.

**If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be directed to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority will expel him/her from the Institution and liable for legal action.**



The selected candidates and his/her parent/guardian will have to execute an agreement bond (Appendix IV & V) during admission. Failure to execute the agreement bond will lead to cancellation of selection.
